ORGANIC

Firm prices for the Organic and in calf North Devon cows due April/ May selling well from £900 - £1000 from JB Dufosse. Young single suckled homebred Charolais from Lord Hylton 9mo to £1005. Angus (9mo) from the same good home eagerly sought to £900 and heifers to £655.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Well, what a trade once again for the younger smart well presented young Continentals. First through was a super entry from Ivor Harris of home bred suckled Limousin steers and heifers (8mo). Trade was flying regularly over £1000 for steers and at £955 for their heifers.

FRIESIAN

Trade outstrips supply again. All grades wanted with fleshed younger steers selling well to £1095 (only 18mo) from PJ & A Boulton of Pucklechurch. Other fleshed steers also keenly bid to £1040 from Tyler Farming Partnership of Calne. Their excellent range of large framed feeding steers also met keen interest selling from £795 to £800 (16-17mo). ANGUS

What a day in the Angus section. The young Angus lead the way with an amazing annual entry of 60 homebred suckled quality steers and heifers 10mo from regular vendor Robert Bull. Trade was electric from the outset. The first 3 bunches of steers all over £1100 and peaked at £1170. All the steers sold from £1000+ and quite remarkably 30 heifers the same age averaged £992 and saw 20 to £1000 topping at £1055. Everyone wanted these top sorts. Plenty of other young Angus Dairy bred were £900 - £1000 with good types from DB & BJ Hill & Sons at £1030 and £915. As the Beef gets dearer the forward stores increase too and most were over £1200 today. J Earwaker from £1235 to £1245, R Taylor & Sons to £1258 and top spot to T & L Hiscock Ltd at £1290. Generally, a shortage of fleshed forward heifers and more needed to meet the trade.

HEREFORD

A good selection on offer met tremendous demand with all grades and ages wanted. Generally younger steers forward with best steers to £1415 (only 21mo) from Will Weaver & family, followed at £1215 (20mo) from J & J Hawkins of Binegar and £1000 from Rob Lessey & family. Yearling steers wanted with well grown 14mo selling to £932 and 9mo to £685 all from Paul & Rob Lucas of East Harptree. Heifers equally sought after with fleshed heifers to £1045 (23mo) and bullers to £902 all from Rob Lessey & family of Wincanton. Yearling heifers also wanted to £760 (12mo) from Paul & Rob Lessey.
