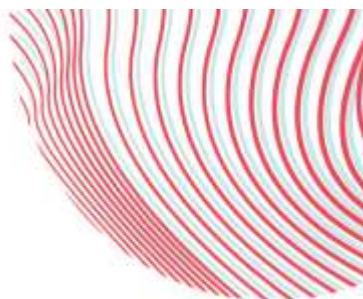

### **ORGANIC**

Only a few Organic as not our special monthly sale, but all those forward saw a brilliant trade throughout. Superb Charolais older steers from Aldenham Farms topped at an amazing £1670, £1570 and £1275. Hard Angus Dairy bred steers to £1090 from Steve Pomeroy.

### **YOUNG CONTINENTAL**

Well, demand continuing to be at the highest levels for all younger cattle. As the finished Beef remains to be in strong demand the knock-on effect is plain to see. ### **ANGUS**

Trade for Angus remains very dear with strong framed steers to £1665 from PW CC & JC Gould. Steers with cover from RC Few & Son to £1395 and £1380 for 18mo. Similar quality steers from The Covey to £1360 and £1310 from DP Tucker. Medium framed steers from The Covey to £1245 and the same price for VL Vincent & Son with their heifers showing shape and potential topped at £1370. Medium framed sorts to £1165.

### **HEREFORD**

Like all other breeds, the Herefords were easily sold through the ring today. Strong forward steers had a blistering trade and peaked at £1365 from RE & D Woodward closely followed by DP Tucker at £1170. Younger 12mo Dairy bred Hereford steers generally £700 - £800. The thicker good feeding heifers were well sold with Woodward family again seeing top prices £1145 - £1230. VL Vincent and Tyler Farming saw their feeding heifers from £900 to £1065. Named sired Herefords still very much wanted.

### **FORWARD CONTINENTAL**

Forward Continental stores a seriously dear trade for all grades. Blue steers with strong frames and potential to gain finish sailed to £1445 for a pair from PW CC & JC Gould. A single Blue with shape from Tyler Farming Partnership to £1350 and another to £1345. Younger sorts from RC Few & Son to £1210 for 17mo and Simmentals from M Lush to £1040. A cracking Charolais heifer from Alice Glover topped the heifers at £1440 and well bred farmed heifers from VL Vincent & Son to £1120 and £1105.

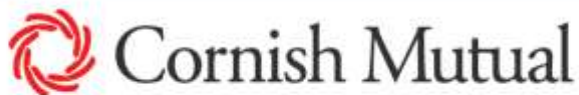
