ANGUS

Some good consignments of Angus forward met firm demand from buyers in attendance. Forward steers with strong frames and flesh to £1060 from JR & RH Williams with a good pen of steers from AW Doel & Sons to £1000. Younger well-bred Angus steers from LW & RJ Wyatt were bid to £880 with medium framed sorts to £815 from Hobden & Barr. Forward heifers to £1020 from RW & HL Young & Sons and £895 from AW Doel & Sons.

CONTINENTALS

Not enough best fleshed Continentals forward but those which were strong with plenty of bone saw brisk bidding. Quality Blue x and Limousin steers from the Williams family to £935 and £960 respectively. Deep bodied Simmentals from MJ Davies peaked at £985. Only limited entries of Continental heifers and those on offer sold to £675 from RW & HL Young. Younger Continentals 12 - 14mo not seeing demand as buyers want more finishing types. April and May will see the younger cattle prices lift as more clients with grazing AFU's come forward.

HEREFORD & DEVON

Several buyers in attendance for Native breeds, ensuring all sold to an improved trade. Strong steers from Hobden & Barr to £1000 with younger steers from the same consignment achieving £880 and £820. Medium framed Herefords to £732 from DC Newberry with heifers from the same consignment to £770 and £725 from HG Davey. A younger well-bred Devon steer from the Baggs family achieved £580 with heifers from the same consignment to £508.

FRIESIANS

The Friesians presented for sale today were generally better types and all sold to a firm trade. Good feeding/summering types from John Baggs 15mo produced competitive bidding to £602. Forward deep bodied steers from AW Doel & Sons were wanted and topped at a very favourable £848.

The small entry of barren cows met a good trade and many more could have been sold. Friesian cows to 112p/kg from HG Davey with SM Sargent to 111p/kg and PH Creed & Son to 107.50p/kg. Young Blue x cows sold to 133p/kg with Limousin x to 97.50p/kg from TFT Handy. Only 2 prime cattle forward today, Friesian heifers to 156.50p/kg, £909.27 from PH Creed & Son and 154.50p/kg, £1115.49 from John Baggs (Farmers) Ltd.
