A strong entry for the time of year with another strong run of quality calves on offer with the best finding a real premium.

## CONTINENTAL BULLS TO £440

A tremendous entry of bulls today with real quality on offer. The top price and winner of the £25 for the best Continental sired bull calf 41 days and under, sponsored by Howard & Sons – Kubota, was a splendid Blue from Jonathon Sprake to £440. Close behind was another tremendous blue at £438 from Stavordale Farm Ltd. Medium types found good competition again similar to last week's flyer with them all trading between £240 - £300. Only the really smallest would be under the £150 mark.

## CONTINENTAL HEIFERS TO £272

Again a strong entry of quality with the 10 best heifers all over £220 with the best to £272 from SH Harris & Son. As with the bulls anything showing potential flew past the £170 mark. Smaller heifers were harder work throughout but regularly nearing the £100 mark.

## NATIVE BULLS TO £292 / NATIVE HEIFERS TO £282

Native heifers were few and far between today. No best younger calves with only smaller and lower end calves on offer, with these trading around the £100 mark. Older sorts met real demand today with a pen of real potential Angus heifers making £282 and Herefords reaching £249 from RM & HM Heal, with only the smallest hard to place. Bulls on the other hand had stronger young calves with the best Angus to £292 from MB & LC Haskell, all medium calves would be £120+ with only the smallest under £100. Something to note was a Shorthorn to £250 from Padfield & Dyke.

## FRIESIANS TO £128 NORWEGIAN REDS TO £88

Friesians were easier on the week with not the quality on offer. The best for some well grown sorts from Padfield & Dyke to £128 with others at £120. A strong run of Norwegian Reds from DE Ford sold well with the best to £88.
