YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Quality in everything and this week saw a number of super well-bred Continental single suckled cattle presented for sale. Trade was very strong and plenty of steers 8 - 12mo £800 - £850. Super quality Limousin and Blue x steers from Andrew Gale 9mo produced amazing bidding and the best pen of Limousin steers topped at £975 and Blues to £890. Heifers from the same home 8mo £700 - £775. Top consignment of Simmentals from the Pike family, Swanage 8 - 10mo regularly over £850 topping at £895. Their 10mo heifers peaked at a blistering £800, young Dairy x Blue heifers 12mo had an excellent day selling to £655. R & J Stevens continuing to sell the very best suckled steers and heifers which saw their 13mo Simmental to £990. Clive House again presenting superb Charolais and his steers 10mo to £900 with heifers to £880 closely followed by the Stevens' to £875. Good Dairy x Continental steers £680 - £740. The less quality types seeing a firm trade but buyers very selective for the better conformed sorts.

HEREFORDS

As with the other breeds the traditional Herefords were wanted throughout the sale. A sizeable entry were on offer and both young and more forward cattle saw premium levels of bidding. Plenty of young steers 9mo from £598 - £625, 13 - 15mo quality steers from RM & CM Stevens £700 - £820, younger heifers with named sires £480 - £550. Interest for bulling types now beginning as the spring approaches, a wonderful consignment of single suckled Herefords from GA Green & Son to £910 to a superb £1145. More best sorts from H Caines and Church Farm Publow to £1188. Top spot for some amazing steers from Andy & Lynne Seare at £1290 and £1195. Plenty of good well covered heifers over £800 this week.

ABERDEEN ANGUS

A lovely run of Angus cattle forward today which enjoyed a solid trade throughout. Best steers to £1140 for both RV & SL Edmunds of Bridgwater and H Caines & Son of Horton. Other quality Angus steers to £1100 from DH Masters, £1095 from LJ Ings and £1090 from F Tovey. Stronger Angus heifers enjoyed a tremendous trade with best heifers to £1030 from JW & JR Seare. Other top heifers to £988 from GA Green & Son and £982 from J & WR Adams. Young steers met an amazing premium with quality 11mo sucklers to £895 from Adrian Bishop. Young heifers wanted, selling from £655 from Nigel Chidley to £675 from Steve Alvis.

FRIESIANS

A cracking entry of Friesians today which enjoyed a strong trade, with top Holsteins to £875 from Little Woolgarston Farm. A lovely run from Lower Bagber Farms with the best Friesians selling to £795 with others at £790 and £678. Overage Friesians to £835 from F Tovey. Medium types to £675 from CG Pulsford. Smaller types sold to an extremely fast trade with the best to £490 from Highgrove Farm and £485 from E & M Seare. But the highlight of the day was a Normande from Mike & Bridget Cox of Bridgwater.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

An excellent show of well presented cattle met a lively trade with strong bidding from several new buyers ringside forcing prices well beyond expectations. Quality reared British Blues sold from £1042 from Ingsdon Farm Ltd, £1100 from RV & SL Edmunds & Son to an amazing £1200 from Andy & Lynne Seare. Fleshed Simmentals met keen demand to £1088 twice from Ingsdon Farm Ltd, Charolais steers from £1038 from Olly & Jenny Hurd and £1050 to £1115 all from Church Farm Publow LLP. Heifers equally sought after with British Blue heifers selling from £1025 from Andy & Lynne Seare, £1052 from Nigel Masters to £1102 from RV & SL Edmunds. Quality Charolais heifers wanted to £1045 from Church Farm Publow LLP and Simmental heifers to £1000 from JW & JR Seare.
