More new season lambs forward today which enjoyed a tremendous trade with best to 215p/kg at £88 from J & D Board with lighter lambs from AM & M Robinson to 197p/kg at £75. More wanted on a weekly basis.

### **PRIME HOGGETS (471) Max. 193p/kg & £87 (SQQ 177.95p/kg)**

Although the SQQ reports otherwise, the trade definitely felt it had a lot more spirit to it. The reason the SQQ is less than last week is due to a large proportion of hill breed ram hoggs which pegged the average back, but standard weight hoggs averaged 188p/kg. Best hoggs to 193p/kg from PJ Pobjoy & Son with 44kg at £84. Lighter hoggs to £70 for 37kg rams from CJK & RA Yates. 48kg hoggs from T Ferris to £87. More wanted on a weekly basis.
