POULTRY

With the calf shed overflowing and cages rustling with birds of all qualities on offer. The best with show potential and others nearing their last eggs, we really did have everything on offer.

PHEASANTS

Pheasants by far one of the most wanted commodities today with no lots under £45 with a Germain Peacock flying to £80. With a pair of Golden Pheasants also to £80.

BANTAMS

The Bantam trade really did rustle some feathers with Light Sussex breeds at £115 per cage. Cuckoo Japanese Bantams to £95 and Buff Sussex to £90.

GUINEA FOWL

Plenty of buyers keen to source their Fowl for the coming year. Top price to a lovely trio of un-sexed at £58 with nearly all £30 - £50. Chocolate & White birds were a premium.

GEESE, TURKEYS & PEACOCKS

Peacocks certainly wanted with pairs to £160, Turkeys fit for the table to £50 for a pair and Geese to £210 for a show stopping gaggle of 2 female Emporias. A cracking pair of Emperor Geese to £180.

PIGEONS

Pigeons from as far as Trafalgar Square flew to a marvellous trade for fancy types. Best Frill Backs to £60 with Fairy Swallows to £50. Some more common types would be at lower levels.

DOMESTIC & ORNAMENTAL DUCKS

A good entry of ducks today boasting real quality met a buoyant trade from beak to bill. Mandarins were the top quack today reaching £210 with others paddling past £100. Traditional Khaki Cambells were afloat throughout with bidders keen to fill their ponds. Standout lots were individual females with people seeing show potential.

DEADSTOCK

A large entry of deadstock forward with a variety of feeders, poultry houses and associated equipment. Top price of the day was a 4ft by 3ft Poultry house selling to £215 from D Conlon, also from the same vendor was a Broody coop run which looked well sold to £130. Drinkers and feeders generally £10 - £15.

HATCHING EGGS

An excellent entry of Hatching eggs sold to a cracking trade with 100% clearance. A good consignment from regular vendor New Forest Poultry with their 6 Large Fowl White Silkie eggs to £12 and 6 Large Fowl Black Silkie eggs to £12. Top price of the day for 6 Copper Black Maran Large Fowl to £14 from Chris Horler. The section was well supported with buyers travelling from far and wide including all the locals.
