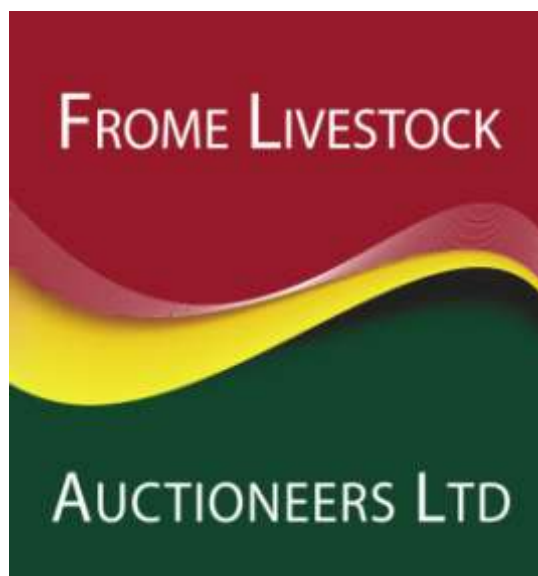

FRIESIANS

A number of quality Friesian and Holstein Friesian were forward and all were sold to an advantage. Strong deep bodied Friesian steers from the Chappell Bros, Steve Creed and Hollands Farms all £850 - £900 with top spot to G & R House at £905. British Friesians were eagerly sought and some quality strong well shaped steers from the Groves Farm Partnership sold to a strong £908.

ANGUS

Included in this sale was a large consignment of 100 Angus x heifers 12 – 14mo off the Salisbury plain from Harley Farm (South). Trade was firm for these hard types with the majority £400 - £500 and best sorts to £550. Forward Angus steers producing a lively trade and plenty of quality named sired steers over £1000 from HE Cotton, LJ Frampton & Son, Trinity Farm and Steve Creed. Top well fleshed quality steers from Phillip & Andy Pobjoy peaked at £1160! Cracking Angus x heifers again from the Pobjoy family and FM Griffin & Sons saw top price to £945 closely followed by Trinity Farms, David Cotton and Will Stitch all over £840. Younger Angus steers just 15mo from LJ Frampton & Son saw tremendous bidding to £1035. Nice younger Angus x grazing heifers regularly £600 - £700 and all met a brisk trade.

HEREFORD

Limited Hereford entries for this sale but all those on offer were well sold. Stronger steers from Trinity Farm to £942 and £1040 was achieved for a super steer with a named sire from the Pobjoy family. Forward feeding heifers with good shape from Trinity Farm and Hollands Farms ranged from £822 - £885.

CONTINENTAL

Plenty of good quality home bred Continentals coming through for this sale. Blue x were particularly sought after with some very smart types from Trinity Farms. Their best Dairy x Blue steers were all over £1000 and topped at a marvellous £1110. Closely Followed by AJ Langley & Son's steers at £1100. Good summering steers from £900 - £950 and easily sold. This sale saw one of the best entries of Blue x heifers for some time, trade was fast and it was very much a contest between Trinity Farm and Steve Creed for top spot. All of these grand Dairy x heifers were mainly over £900 which firmly saw Steve Creed top at £990 and Trinity Farm to £950. Forward Simmental steers to £1045. Younger 15mo Blonde x single suckled steers presented by TG Cox sold extremely well at a fabulous £990! Thick well fleshed Simmental heifers for soon finishing presented by G & R House created brisk bidding by a strong complement of buyers to £1045. Quality summering Limousin heifers from Will Stitch were wanted to £815.

UTM HEIFERS: 180/50p/kg £1,111 for a Hereford from MR Meredith, Bath.

An entry predominantly made up of over 30month cattle which met a strong trade for the plainer goods on offer seeing Charolais to 169.50p/kg or £931.95, Limousins to 163.50p/kg or £1015.35 and Shorthorn to 161.50p/kg or £896.88. A handful of underage met strong competition to 180.50p/kg or £1111.88 and £1074.92 from MR Meredith of Bath.

CULL COWS (35)

More cows could have easily been sold with trade on fire. Top price of 141.50p/kg to Hollands Farms with DB & BJ Hill & Sons seeing good sorts to 137p/kg. A number of plainer Beef sorts to 111.50p/kg.
