LARGE FOWL

A stunning entry of birds forward which sold to a flying trade. Prices to note: Trio of Light Sussex Pullets to £175, 2 Light Sussex Pullets from the same good home also flew close at £145. A pair of wonderful Gold Partridge Brahma from Henry Cossins looked well sold at £65. Regular supporters Abbey Batch had a pair of Chocolate Silkie Pullets they looked smooth & sweet at £55. Two nicely marked silver laced Wyandotte Pullets from Sharon & Mark Howe of Norfolk £80. A Christian from Norfolk had two Buff Orpington Pullets flying high at £78 and lovely Wheaten Maran Pullets from CS Pointing reached £75, another classy Trio of Cuckoo Maran RW James from Cornwall sold to £105

BANTAMS

Another eye-catching run of quality Bantams here at Frome. Paul Tory had a flying trade with two Dutch Hens to £58. A pair of Black Silkie from Tom Buck of Norfolk reached £50 with a nice trio of Furnace Pekin racing to £65 & £62 at only 14 weeks of age from J Stott. Two Silver Sebright Pullets from P Allen sold to £50 with a nice pair of Ko Shomo to £80 from Matthew Hulf. A large entry in this section generally sold well with most Pairs/Trios trading at £30-£45

BOXED YOUNGSTOCK

A nice entry of birds with Broody hens & chicks being popular. Matthew Hulf had a nice cream crested Legbar hen & 9 female chicks to £50, a nice Light Sussex Bantam with 7 chicks and another with 12 from the same good home traded between £29-£32.50. Indian Runner Ducklings in bunches of 3 sold to £27 with Quails from S Little proving popular selling to £34.

The weather didn't suit the Ducks until later in the day. Quality pairs of call Ducks generally floated between £40 and £45 from Tom Buck & S Harvey. A nice pair of German Pekin from Graham Hicks, Owesetry waddled their way to £65.

Three stunning Khaki Campbell females looked well sold at £80. Quality Birds again seemed to be the call of the day.

Ornamental Ducks A pair of Ring Teal splashed sold to £100 from Tom Buck with a pair of Mandarin from the same home reaching £45. A very nice pair of Mandarin from S & A Poultry sold to £60, while a pair of white-faced Whistlers from E Parrott hit the high notes at £50.

Pigeons & Doves A nice show of birds on offer at this sale generally saw trading between £5-£6 per bird with the more unusual types £25-£30. A pair of Russian Tumbler rose to £60 from Tom Buck while a nice Badge Musker Wolverhampton Tumblers reached £50 from JAJ Pearce

Domestic Geese A muddy wet summer squashed demand, however despite the conditions one female Brecon Buff reached £60 with two females west of England's making £60.

Peafowl A small but perfect entry saw a pair of Blue Pied reach £170.

Ornamental Geese & Swans A pair of Nene Pinioned made £120 from G Pass.

Turkeys Looking to avoid the xmas trade saw a trio of Blue to £50 and 3 female slates to £70 from regular Supporter L Trott

Ornamental Pheasants First lot of the day a Golden Pheasant Male jumped onto the perch at £60 and set the pace. A mixed pen of Golden unsexed 2-3mo looked serious at £90 from G Manning. P Cook had a pair of white Ornamental reach £75.

Guinea Fowl Two white from Tom Buck sold to £50. A Trio from Mr Woodall sold to £60. A pen of 3 females from C Rust were well sold to £45 from S Little, while Pairs of English Partridge reached £45 from regular supporter P Cook.

HYBRIDS

This new section proved popular. Two female Gold tops from J Woodward sold to £26. A nice run of Cream Leghorn x White Leghorn F1 X at only 20 weeks were sold at £27 per two females. Speckled, Columbian, Bluebell & White star pullets POL traded between £8-£11. Coucou Pullet POL from E Shorter looked well sold to £38.

DEADSTOCK

A nice 4x4 Brooder house from Ronnie, Taunton Sweet sold to £130. A tidy Petrol Generator to £80. Regular supporter Darrell Conlon Pencoed Bridgend with the usual run of well-built poultry houses had a 6x3 House to £170, 4x3 House to £230 and a 6x3 Ark to £145. An assortment of various poultry crates traded between £25-£35.

HATCHING EGGS

A Bantam sized entry led to 100% clearance. Matthew Hulf had a cracking trade with 6 Ko Shamo to £10. Most ½ Dozen lots between £4-£6.
