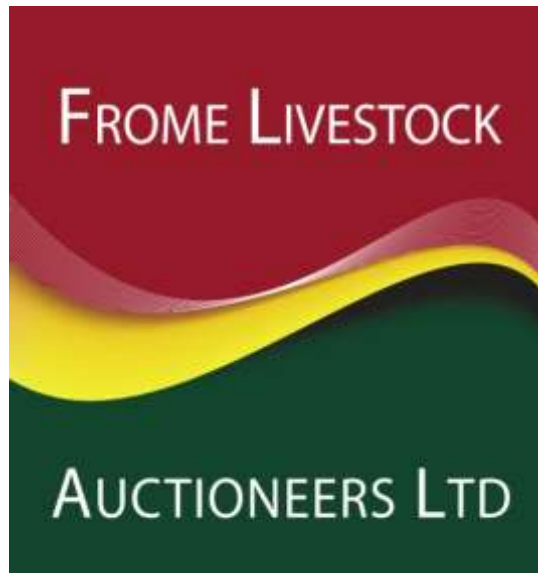

STEERS TO £1390 HEIFERS TO £1228

Excellent numbers of stores coming forward for our September sale with almost 300 penned for the auction. Good entries of stronger cattle met with a brisk trade throughout, and all cattle met the current finished trade were well sold. Plenty of Blue x and super good shaped steers from Crutchley Farms, David Foot Ltd & DR Stranger & Sons all £1100 - £1200 and top spot to DR Stanger & Sons to £1235. Feeding Blue steers £800 - £900. Forward Blue x heifers from the same home generally £950 - £1080. Wonderful thick well conformed Simmental steers from the Drake family topped at a tremendous £1390. More super single suckled Simmental steers from MD & DR James 15 - 18mo had a blistering trade with prices regularly £1000 - £1200 peaking at £1255. Heifers from the same home found equally as keen demand topping at £1228.

ANGUS & HEREFORD

Demand for the forward short term cattle was good which saw steers over 20mo from David Foot Ltd & RH & CM Johnston from £1000 - £1170. Richard Stevens produced top honours for his named sired steers at £1218. David Foot's best heifers to £1030 and just pipped at the post by Crutchley Farms to £1035. Some well presented Herefords coming through and all were wanted, Crutchley Farms saw their best steer at a massive £1292, very closely followed by those smart types from SH Lawrence & Son at £1262, £1220 and £1160. Demand for the stronger heifers very lively with the Lawrence family seeing prices at £1228 and Crutchley Farms at £1080.

FRIESIAN

Several Friesian Holstein & Holstein Friesian steers on offer this time, trade was a little more sticky with buyers very selective. The better types were all £900 - £1000 and a few very good sorts to £1018. Plainer steers were more common this time and to be honest saw buyers more hesitant. Overall a really good day with all regular buyers in attendance and just the longer term cattle a little steadier.
