Quality was certainly on offer here at Frome for our Autumn Graded Show & Sale. Vendors & Buyers prepared to travel distances from North, South, East & West from Cornwall, Norfolk, Wales & Jersey. Frome certainly is proving to be one of the leading sales

LARGE FOWL

What an entry forward for the last sale of 2021 with all quality selling to a flying trade. Congratulations to G Brown of Ringwood for taking the overall Champion & Champion Large Fowl with a splendid pair of Light Sussex later selling to £390. Other prices to note include a Trio of Silver Laced Poland to £110 from Tom Buck of Norfolk. Two Black Cochon Pullets to £105 for S Richardson. A lovely single Salmon Faverolle to £100 for K Williams of Exeter. A trio of Indian Game sold well to £95 for K Barnard. Another pair of Light Sussex Pullets to £95 for G Brown & Two Silver Laced Wyandotte's to £90 for S Howe of Norfolk. A pretty trio of Partridge Wyandotte for C Fisher from Totnes to £90. Cochon Pullets to £80 for A Christian, Cream Legbar to £72 from N Smith & £70 for Light Sussex for C Lark. Any older birds were much harder to sell.

BANTAMS

A wonderful entry of Bantams was met by a brisk trade with a huge number of buyers keen to buy. 1ST Quality birds were especially sought with buyers willing to reward well bred birds. A super entry from N Smith of Norton Wood saw his trio of Light Sussex to £110. Seabright's saw a flying trade all day to sell to £75 from C Fisher. A Trio of Salmon Faverolle sold to £85 from R Thomas from St Austell, Silver Laced Wyandotte Pullets to £70 from S Howe. Plenty of Old English Game Pullets sold well all Day to top at £70 from C Fisher. A wonderful entry from New Forest Poultry saw a single Mauve American Silkie Pullet sell at £70. A trio of singles from M Hills sold at £65. K Barnard's Trio of Dark Laced Indian Game sold to £52. Black Rosecombs sold to £50 from A Denning, 3 Copper Marans to £50.

BOXED YOUNGSTOCK

Another small light entry cheeped all the way with the best to £16 for Chamois Poland 6 Weeks old. Mixed Guinea Fowl at 5 Weeks unsexed looked roasting at £14. Looking forward to seeing you all on 26th March 2022

ORNAMENTAL & DOMESTIC DUCKS, QUAIL, TURKEYS, GEESE, PEAFOWL GUINEA FOWL & PIGEONS

DUCKS An exceptionally large entry of over 200 cages Ducks which everyone went quackers for. Mr Thomason who travelled all the way from Jersey headlined the day seeing a trio of Apricots to £310 & £300 for a trio of white calls. Pen after pen waddled past £100 with £50 being the average price.

ORNAMENTAL DUCKS Still as very popular filling the shelf with colours. A pair of Blonde Mandarins soared away to £100 with Carolinas to £70 many more past £50.

GEESE excelled all expectations to top at £170 for a trio of Sebastopol with a pair making £115. Buff Backs to £160 and Chinese to £120

ORNAMENTAL GEESE really caused a gaggle seeing Red Breasted Pinioned to £390 & £380. Only to be beaten by a pair of Emperors to £400

SWANS A pair of Black Swans knew their worth swanning off to a huge £605.

ORNAMENTAL PHEASANTS Certain Breeds in huge demand topping to £360 for a pair of Himalayan Monals from Ed Godwin with another to £250. Lady Amherst's sold to £100 and a Female Temmincks Tragopan to £100

GUINEA FOWL As ever popular topping to £70 per 6 un-sexed beaks with 2 females to £65.

QUAIL found plenty of customers to top at £18.

PEAFOWL Peacocks popular today with a pair of India Blues topping at £120.

TURKEYS Christmas was definitely coming in the Turkey pens with orders queuing up! 3 Female Bourbon Reds filled the roasting tins to £200 with a pair to £80

PIGEONS & DOVES A marvellous showing from Trafalgar Square saw Frill Backs to £55 and well-fed Kings to £35.

HYBRIDS

An unexpectant bright trade for the Hybrids with Gold top Pullets proving very popular. Traditional Gold top Large fowl from N Smith flew to £64, £59 & £70 for pens of 3. Most large Feather commercial hybrid trading in the £6-£8 area and Bantam x Breeds generally £5-£6 per bird. 3 x Bluebell Female cages proving popular trading at £40-£43 per lot from C Rust.

HATCHING EGGS

A limited Late season entry saw an excellent trade with 100% clearance. Top prices smashed @ £13 for ½ Dozen mixed Silkie Bantam. Most lots generally trading £8-£10 per ½ Dozen
