STEERS TO £1310 HEIFERS TO £1250

Strong entries of TB Cattle forward for this October sale. Although several less buyers around the ring due to the maize harvest those who were forward were well prepared to bid for the right types. As always the strong cattle produced the liveliest of trade with plenty of cattle of all breeds over £1000. A wonderful consignment of Angus coming to Frome this week from Rex & Jean Horler who saw their 34mo home bred single suckled steers & heifers created very fast bidding throughout. They topped the steer section on 7 occasions with their best at a marvellous £1310 and heifers to £1200. They missed the top spot for heifers as Hollands Farms saw their grand Dairy x Angus to £1250. Plenty of good middle age Angus from £850 - £1000. Herefords saw mainly lighter weight feeding heifers on offer which saw prices from £800 - £900 with good types from D & P Yeatman to £915. Dairy x steers with name sires from £900 - £990 and a super pen of 12 – 14mo suckled Hereford x Charolais steers from Rob Fry took top spot to £1000. Some excellent strong Continentals were presented for sale and in particular the Blue x. SH Lawrence & Sons' had some super types which saw their steers to £1270 & £1200, closely followed by PW CC & JC Gould at £1155 & £1150. Blue heifers saw keen interest too, the Gould's topped at £1045 and younger sorts from D & P Yeatman to £820. Not too many Simmentals & Charolais on offer but all were well sold throughout the day. Best Simmental steers with good conformation from the Gould family to £1195 closely followed by their heifers at £1130. The Charolais were mainly younger but all suckler bred with excellent shape. Kate Isgar topped the steers with her 16mo to £1075 and Roby Fry's 13mo to £1000. Only a handful of Holstein Friesians through the ring for this sale, strong fleshed types sold well to £1000 from Hollands Farms but younger leaner sorts harder to place however this has been evident in all breeds this week.

Good to see better numbers here and it certainly attracts more accounts and results in a faster trade so please keep them coming. Top price to Frome regulars DB & BJ Hill who's run of out of parlour Friesian cows sold to a top of £909 or 122.450p/kg and a younger type from Barry Cooper sold to 125.50p/kg. A well-fleshed Brown Swiss from SH Lawrence sold to £1030 or 139.50p/kg. A run of fat cattle from the same home saw lightweight heifers to 203.50p/kg, 198.50p/kg and 197.50p/kg or £1087, £1042 and £1003. More are needed, make use of the monthly TB market to maximise values.
