Holstein Friesians to 167.50p/kg or £1365 from Wareham Partners. Hard working cross bred grazing types to 138.50p/kg with Friesians to 129.50p/kg from SA Legg & Sons. Beef Shorthorns to 174.50p/kg from Home Farm Partnership saw their cows top at £1403. Angus & Hereford cows continue to trade at similar levels at 163.50p/kg and 162.50p/kg respectively from IJ Masters & Partners. A super day in the Dairy ring with something for everyone. Quality fresh milk wanted throughout and some excellent types were forward. Filer & Miller again presenting smart calved Holstein Friesian home bred heifers which saw "Atrium" daughters at £2280 and "Bouncer" daughters at £2180, closely followed by a "Tendoy" heifer from Richard & Jan Leigh at £1900. A good annual consignment of In calf (out of pattern) crossbred heifers and cows from Simon Martin Farms produced competitive strong bidding. 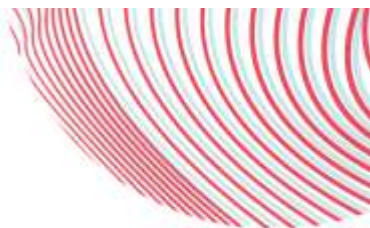

A great entry produced a much firmer than anticipated trade with several new faces around the ring wanting to fill orders.

GRAZING/FEEDING COWS

A good trade for the few feeding/grazing cows which were on offer seeing Longhorn cows to £905.

FEEDING BULLS

Generally feeding bulls steadier but all were sold. 8-10mo Blue x bulls from Townsend Farming selling to £630. Less shaped Angus x Dairy to £400.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Buyers wanting the better types as usual and prepared to give the money however, all seem to want to buy their cattle less if possible, owing to the higher pressure on feed costs. Overall, a very pleasing trade throughout the section. Another cracking consignment of quality Simmental steers and heifers from Sid Brown, Isle of Wight which saw 8mo steers at £800, his heifers were well sought at £730 and 6mo to £700. Some nice runs of Charolais suckled calves today from regular supporters R & J Stevens presented some outstanding cattle 14mo steers at £1010 and 11mo at £930. Younger quality steers 7mo from Rob & Julia Banwell at £780 and £700. Their heifers saw a wonderful trade too at £685. A keen interest in the Blues and providing the conformation was good today they were well sold. An outstanding 10mo steer from LP Norman & Sons at £910, Dairy bred Blue heifers (10mo) were sold to an advantage at £620. Well-shaped Limousins (11-13mo) steers and heifers presented by the Attrill family were eagerly sought at £858 and £645. Dairy crosses saw the buyers selective again and demanding those with good conformation.

FRIESIAN

Not too many Friesians forward but overall, a very firm trade for the better types. An outstanding run of strong Holstein Friesian steers from SC Jones, saw tremendous bidding with bunches at £1328, £1232 and £960. Younger British Friesians saw a slightly firmer trade at £605.
