


Some cracking sorts forward today suiting all requirements from butcher's heifers through to those requiring further feeding. Large framed Aberdeen Angus from Tom and Ann Rossiter to a tremendous £1788 or 244.5ppk for Austin Smith's tremendous Hereford steer.

In general, the native bred types were more fleshed today with Angus steers typically trading 218-225ppk, with Laverstoke Park Produce seeing 228.5ppk and 227.5ppk from Rossiter & Son.

Herefords continue to sell exceedingly well with Austin Smith's tremendous cattle selling at 244.5ppk, 244.5ppk 243.5ppk & 239.5ppk topping at £1,668. A lovely consignment of Simmentals from Charlie Butcher sold to 240.5ppk or £1535 with others at 235.5ppk and £1498. Limousins followed this trade with Pat Apsey's

'pet' Limousin steer selling well to 239.5ppk or £1499. Dexter steers from James Penny to 148.5ppk and Red Poll steers to 213.5ppk from Richard Gregory.

Heifers were typically shorter legged types, with Charlie Butchers Angus heifers selling to 229ppk or £1443 again from Tom and Ann Rossiter. Feeding Blue heifers to 223.5ppk or £1276 from BJ & EM Yandle and a



young Fleckvieh heifer from Tom and Emily Voizey to 234ppk.



BREEDING BULLS

Only one senior bull forward this week but plenty of trade and looked well sold at £1700.

What a trade in this section. Quite honestly even I am running out of things to say about the recent trade at Frome. Our annual consignment of 30 quality suckled home bred Blonde steers and heifers 9 – 10mo from Alan Pike & family saw blistering prices throughout. His best Blonde steer (10mo) peaked at £1150 with plenty over £1000. His best heifers were not far behind (10mo) to £1128 and regularly from £850 - £900. 
