

Only one set forward this week but what a trade. Super young Simmental cow with 3mo heifer calf from CW Gould raced away to top at £2020! More needed after the Candlemas Sales have been completed.

Trade quite remarkable throughout the sale. Not enough younger suckled types to go around but all so desperately wanted. Quality Limousin home bred suckled 8 – 12mo steers and heifers from regular vendor Will Stitch produced tremendous bidding with steers at £1075 and heifers at £1005. Cracking 11-13mo suckled Charolais steers from David & Liz Brimble & family commanded strong bidding to £1095 with 17mo steers and heifers from the same home saw prices at tremendous levels to £1212 and £1080 respectively. Dairy crosses saw Blue x steers 15mo from Stonemark at £900 while 11mo Blue x steers out of crossbred cows from DIVA (Sherborne) Ltd settled at £758. Plenty of Dairy x Blue heifers 18-19mo well over £900 peaking at £950 from D & P Yeatman. It was a day for the Blues as we saw an excellent consignment from IW Lane & Sons. Although not farm assured their 24mo steers had an amazing trade with best to £1585 and often over £1300. Similar aged heifers peaked at £1300. Buyers really keen on these good conformation types. Hard out lying Blue x once again from Evershot Farms were very easily sold 20mo at £1045 for steers and £925 for heifers. More quality Dorset cattle coming from VL Vincent & Son and although over 40mo their Limousin steers topped the sale at an impressive £1640. Simmental heifers from the same home at £1150. Thicker better fleshed Blue x heifers were presented by regular supporters PW CC & JC Gould which all had top prices at £1300. Overall, an outstanding trade with guite unbelievable demand.

Cracking suckler bred steers sold to £900 from DR & EA Brimble, with Dairy bred steers sold to £800 from DIVA (Sherborne) Ltd and £790 from A James of Wimborne. Dairy bred heifers to £570 from DIVA. **FRIESIAN** 

Fewer Friesians forward but best steers flew to £1050 from the Gould family of Norton Ferris who had others at £1045. Best Friesian heifers to £1095 from Evershot Farms Ltd who had others at £965. Yearling steers rocked to £758 from DIVA Ltd with others to £678.


