With numbers remaining tight nationally, the barren cow trade is quite exceptional. New market records with commercial barren cows to £1999.28 for E M Horn & Son's Limousin and 220.5p/kg for Des Beatty's Charolais cow.

All types wanted with plenty of non-assured cattle trading over 170+p/kg. Pat Apsey's non-assured Limousin to 184.50p/kg or £1668. Blues from Morton Farm Partnership trading at just shy of 200p/kg and to £1546, with others from M Webber to 186.6p/kg, 183.5p/kg and 182.5ppk. Simmentals from S Taylor to 193.5p/kg or £1374 who also had top price Hereford at 190.5p/kg or £1415.

Dairy types were variable as you would expect for those coming out of the parlour in January, from hard working Holstein Friesians to those which have benefitted from the TMR! No real best types forward, but plenty of cows trading upwards of 160p/kg to top at 176.5p/kg (£1398) for Holstein Friesians from C G Pulsford & Partners and British Friesians from 172.5p/kg (£1204).

All in the cows averaged just under 170p/kg, including all those lighter framed Cross Bred Dairy types and very plain outwintered cattle.




