

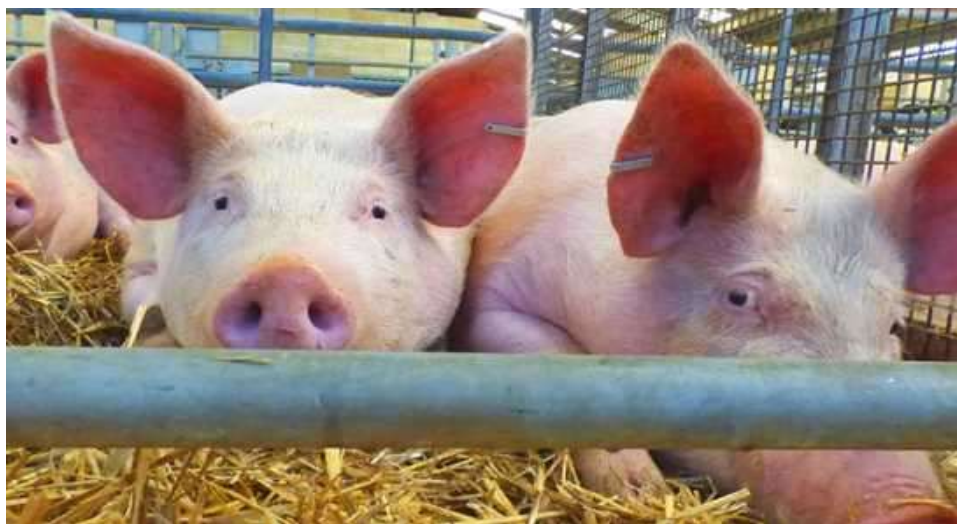

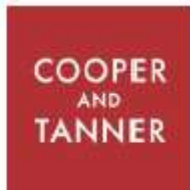



FORWARD CONTINENTAL

What a trade at Frome today with a traditional massive Candlemas trade forcing prices well beyond vendors expectations. The excellent consignment from Puncknowle Manor Estate of Dorchester took top honours with their Blue steers selling to an outstanding £1690 (only 23mo).
