

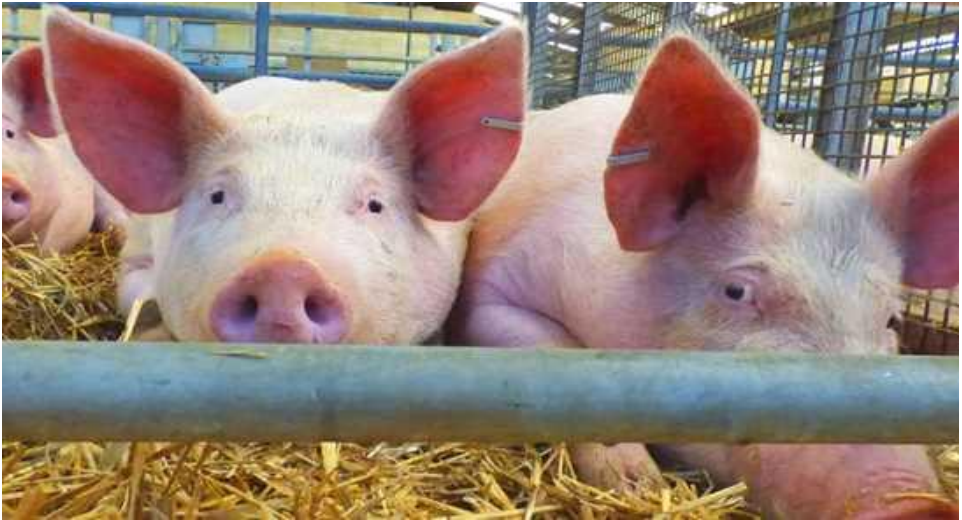

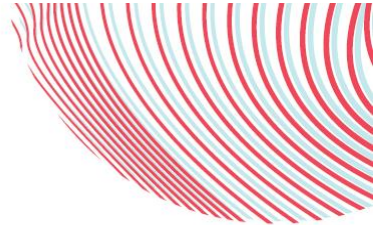

Another fantastic day at Frome with strong bidding forcing the trade beyond expectations.

SUCKLER COWS

This week saw a number of suckler in calf cows and heifers coming forward for sale. A super consignment from JH & JA Cool, IOW, created furious bidding and regularly over £1450 with the best March due heifers to £1640 & £1550. Aberdeen Angus heifers from the same home to £1380. A consignment of North Devon pedigree older cows due May/June to North Devon sire from C French, Chelwood, often over £1150 and peaked twice at £1340. Leaner March/April due Red Poll (7y/o) cows commanded keen interest generally £750-£950. Super Simmental x cow with Angus steer saw a blistering trade at £1950. Older pedigree Simmental cow with heifer calf from Hillside Farm to £1850. Young 14mo pedigree Simmental Bulls £1170. Super quality young 20mo pedigree Angus bull from local vendors GJ & JA Hendy produced a strong trade at £1700!

FEEDING BULLS

Young feeding bulls and rigs well sold again this week. 25mo lean Charolais rig to £1105 and 11mo Angus rig to £780.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

A wonderful trade once again for all the young suckled Continentals. Smart Limousins 7-8mo from Ian Winter saw steers at £995 and heifers £835. 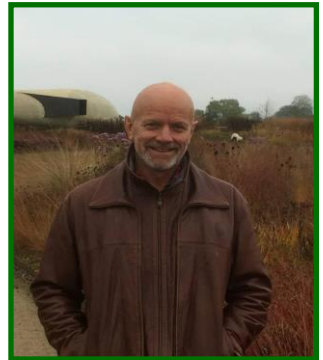
