



**Another fantastic day at Frome with strong bidding forcing the trade beyond expectations.**

### **SUCKLER COWS**

This week saw a number of suckler in calf cows and heifers coming forward for sale. A super consignment from JH & JA Cool, IOW, created furious bidding and regularly over £1450 with the best March due heifers to £1640 & £1550. Aberdeen Angus heifers from the same home to £1380. A consignment of North Devon pedigree older cows due May/June to North Devon sire from C French, Chelwood, often over £1150 and peaked twice at £1340. Leaner March/April due Red Poll (7y/o) cows commanded keen interest generally £750-£950. Super Simmental x cow with Angus steer saw a blistering trade at £1950. Older pedigree Simmental cow with heifer calf from Hillside Farm to £1850. Young 14mo pedigree Simmental Bulls £1170. Super quality young 20mo pedigree Angus bull from local vendors GJ & JA Hendy produced a strong trade at £1700!

### **FEEDING BULLS**

Young feeding bulls and rigs well sold again this week. 25mo lean Charolais rig to £1105 and 11mo Angus rig to £780.

### **YOUNG CONTINENTAL**

A wonderful trade once again for all the young suckled Continentals. Smart Limousins 7-8mo from Ian Winter saw steers at £995 and heifers £835. Plenty of Limousin top sorts from regular vendors Philliols Farm seeing 15mo steers at £1245, 10mo at £1125 and 11mo heifers at £865. Some good suckled Charolais coming forward with Richard & Jeff Stevens 10mo steers at £1050 and PW Fry & Sons 11mo steers at £1165 and £1132. An outstanding consignment of Simmental x steers and heifers from PF Best & Son of East Creech; demand for these top-quality cattle was amazing with their 15mo steers £1235, 11mo £1100 and 11-12mo heifers £980. Dairy x Continentals all selling at high levels. Good conformation British Blue x steers 13mo £1000 & £885 from N & B Hutton and British Blue x heifers with bulling potential at £960. Dairy x Simmentals equally wanted at £980 & £890. Overall, another very strong trade at Frome this week.

## ANGUS

What a trade again at Frome with quality steers with good potential selling to £1380 from AE Weaver & Son and £1325 from Isgar & Sons of Shaftesbury. Younger feeding steers met fast bidding to £1290 (20mo) from Martin & Paul Few & family of Warminster, £1200 (18mo) from Isgar & Sons and £1135 (17mo) from Kenny Rostigina and family of the New Forest. Forward heifers also keenly sought after and selling to £1315 (20mo) from RC Few & Son, £1265 (23mo) from Cartwright Hignett Partners, £1255 (28mo) from PW CC & JC Gould and £1190 (23mo) from AE Weaver & Son. Quality bulling heifers sold well to £1140 (19mo) from Merryfield Farmers and £1100 (17mo) from Kenny Rostigina & family. Yearling steers were another highlight selling well above expectations to £1135 (11mo) from James Gay of Bath and £965 (14mo) from Isgar & Son. Yearling heifers wanted and sold well to £930 (13mo) from FL Newall & Son of Beaminster and £780 (11mo) from James Gay.

## HEREFORD

A good entry of well-presented cattle met tremendous bidding with quality steers selling to an amazing £1380 from RE & D Woodward of Norton Ferris, £1200-£1210 (18-19mo) from Merryfield Farmers, £1165 (18mo) from both Tom Lawrence & family and Isgar & Sons. Younger feeding steers sold well to £1030 (16mo) from Houghton Farming of Poole. 
