

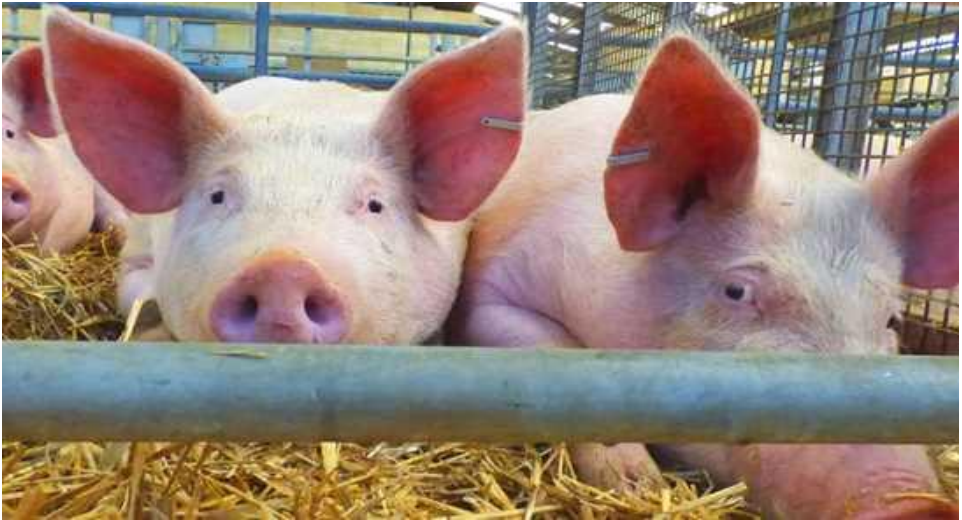

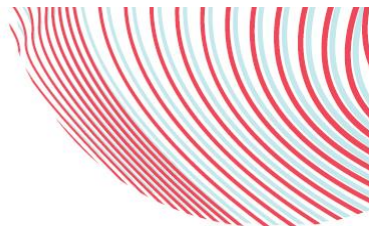

Another fantastic Friday at Frome Market with over 720 store cattle forward and sold to a seriously dear trade again. Buyers travelling from up and down the country looking for all grades of store cattle.

ORGANIC

Frome is continuing its tradition to be the name for Organic cattle with over 150 head penned for our monthly sale. Plenty of different breeds of all ages coming forward and trade at top levels once again. Good younger 8-11mo came from LJ Jolliffe & Sons who made the trip from Weymouth and saw best 8mo steers at £1002 and heifers to £790. 11mo heifers from Paul Britten & family easily to £808 and buyers wanting named sire cattle. Another consignment of 50 hard Continentals from Gore Farm Partners 9-10mo saw their open yarded Charolais steers at £1010, £970 and £968, with heifers to £820, £780 and £772. Younger Angus x named sire steers from Lord Hylton 10mo produced excellent bidding at £970 with heifers to £690. More forward Angus steers 22mo from the same home topped at £1625 and regularly over £1300; their best heifers were outstanding types at £1485 and £1310. Harder coated 17mo outwintered Angus x Dairy steers from Moxey Farm had a blistering trade at £930 and pipped by their heifers at £940. Will Best & family saw their 20mo Angus steers top at £1100 and were very well sold. Chave & Foster continuing to support the sale with the best single suckled Simmentals and at just 20-22mo saw steers at £1580, heifers to £1465 and £1455. Demand was superb for these top class cattle. More Organic buyers coming to Frome again for this sale.

COWS & CALVES

A cracking trade for cows and calves again. Deep bodied Charolais x cow due end of April with 10mo steer calf produced very competitive bidding to £2430. Super March due Limousin x and Hereford x cows from local vendor John Wareham at £1615 and £1575.

FEEDING BULLS

Smart Charolais 10mo bulls from the Seager family saw excellent prices to £1000. Super homebred Blonde Aquitaine rigs easily sold at £1095 presented by PE Webb, Pucklechurch.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

No problem to sell the younger Continentals again this week and more quality types could have been well sold. Cracking suckled Limousin 9mo heifer from Abbey Maclean, Romsey realised a fantastic trade topping at £1070. Some wonderful consignments of Charolais coming through the ring. LC Seager provided us with his usual top quality Charolais steers & heifers (9mo) which were all eagerly sought with best pen of steers at £1195 and heifers to £920. Richard & Jeff Stevens saw their well bred thick set Charolais heifers 9-11mo to £940 and £860. Dairy x Charolais found a ready supply of willing bidders with N & B Hutton's 14-15mo heifers to £930. Not so many Blues forward today but plenty of trade for the right sorts. Steve North & family once again selling their excellent 9-10mo suckled steers & heifers which topped at £1060 and heifers to £800. Overall, another excellent day at Frome.

ANGUS

An unbelievably dear trade for Angus steers and heifers again today driven by serious competition around the ring. Forward steers rocketed home at £1470 for 23mo with form and stature from AE Weaver & Son. RA Salter being rewarded for the journey from the Isle of Wight with steers to £1450. RC Garraway steers to £1410 and £1330 from RC Few & Son. Heifers with strength and cover topped at £1492 from PW CC & JC Gould. Heifers from AE Weaver & Son to £1440 and £1380 and MJ Blow to £1320. Steers with frame and potential trading between £1050 and £1330 and heifers £970 to £1300. Medium term sorts to £1225 for 17mo from KE & AM Rostigina and £1035 for 19mo from AW Doel & Sons. Younger Angus steers from WC & P Craig & Son reached £1040 for 10mo and £1038 from Delcombe Downs for the same age, both single suckled.

HEREFORD

Demand continues to exceed supply with fast bidding producing an amazing trade. Forward steers wanted and sold well from £1490 to £1500 (22mo – 31mo) all from PJ Harvey of Bishop Sutton. Younger steers were keenly sought after selling to £1295 (20mo) from Bown & Son Ltd of Haydon, £1220 from Marelands Farms Ltd of Farnham from £1120 to £1150 (all 19mo) from Merryfield Farms and similar steers to £1130 (19mo) from Dave Flux & Claire Griffin of Isle of Wight. Forward heifers wanted with several consignments of quality bullers selling to £1100 (21-24mo) from Ian Creed of Glastonbury, Mitchell Brothers of Merriott and AW Doel & Sons Ltd of Chippenham. Younger heifers with bulling potential also sold well to £1010 (19mo) from Marelands Farm Ltd, £970 from Isgar & Sons, Shaftesbury and Mitchell Bros and £965 from PE Webb of Pucklechurch. Yearling steers met a tremendous trade to £1005 from Foremore Ltd, £970 from Bown & Son Ltd and £915 (14mo) from Ian Creed. Yearling heifers also keenly sought to £860 (12mo) from both Marelands Farms Ltd and Foremore Ltd.
