

#### **ORGANIC**

Plenty of different breeds of all ages coming forward and trade at top levels once again. Good younger 8-11mo came from LJ Jolliffe & Sons who made the trip from Weymouth and saw best 8mo steers at £1002 and heifers to £790. 11mo heifers from Paul Britten & family easily to £808 and buyers wanting named sire cattle.
