While the weather was a worry as more Northern areas were hit with blizzards demand for the younger cattle continued to be strong throughout. 7-8mo hard coated Charolais steers from Cutts Agriculture peaked at £840. Quality suckled Limousin steers 10-11mo from regular vendor RE Dury & Son were well sold at £1100 and Simmental x steers at £1050. More good Limousin from GL Habberfield 10-11mo had plenty of interest with steers at £1152 and heifers to £790. The show stoppers today were presented by the Butler family (PB Farm Enterprises) as well as their older types, their 30 11mo home bred single suckled steers and heifers produced un stoppable bidding! Steers were all over £1100 with best pens at £1160, £1190 and £1205. Heifers from the same good home saw equally as keen interest topping at £1015.

A number of super Blonde came with a smart annal consignment from PR & JR Best, Ditteridge. These well presented cattle were well sold as their 10mo steers with good conformation saw pens at £1140, £1102 and £900. Heifers generally £750 - £900 topping at £955. Cracking Dairy Blue x heifers 14mo to £960 and 16mo steers to 1110. Overall a super day in this section with plenty of quality forward.

ANGUS

A record breaking day in the Angus section with forward steers from DH Masters & Son flying to £1855! Well bred steers from WO & V Dibden sold to £1580 (21mo) and £1570 (19mo) from AM & RS Rich. Heifers from the same good home to £1325 (17mo) and £1230. Medium term younger Angus steers with shape and potential reached £1185 from M & MR Massey with others over the £1000 mark. Heifers from Perry Farm Ltd to £1105 for 17mo. Suckler bred Angus from NJS & MZ Tuke reached £1140 for 11mo and £1075 the same age. Heifers again from NJS & MZ Tuke to £1020 for 11mo. Angus steers and heifers very much in demand evident by the strong prices achieved.

Firm competition for Hereford again this week with the strongest sorts topping at £1385 from AE Weaver & Sob for a pair of steers. 21mo steers from B & P White to £1200 and £1160 from I Closier. Heifers topped at £1295 from CG Pulsford & Partners and £1210 from M & MR Massey. Younger medium term steers to £1245 for 18mo from PA & RJ Lucas and £1230 for 17mo from Perry Farm Ltd. Heifers the same age from Sparsholt College to £1025 for an even pen of 5. A super run of suckler bred Hereford steers from PJ Pobjoy & Son reached £1025 for 11mo.

FRIESIAN

Plenty of Friesian coming through this week and all were very well sold. Wonderful, well covered Holstein Friesian steers 17mo from CY & YS Bennett commanded premium prices at £1125 and £1255 with all wanting these good types. Harder coated sorts from Nick & Ben Hutton (16-17mo) regularly £990 £1030, softer Holsteins from LO Clothier from £715 - £775. A few older Holstein Friesian heifers were wanted and topped at £1180 from DH Masters & Son.
