Commercially we were short on top quality freshly calved heifers, but those forward produced a lively trade with a super entry from David Jones & family seeing 3 times over £2000 and peaked at £2300. Freshly calved Friesian type cows from WL Baxandall, Isle of Wight, at £2020. Bulling and just served heifers finding trade a little more steady with nice home-bred Friesians from G & A Habershon to £835. In calf Jersey heifers sold well to £940.

Included in the week's sale was the 2<sup>nd</sup> consignment of 50 in milk/ in calf Friesian Holstein cows from the Hazeldene Farm herd, Kent.

Demand was very firm and although all loose housed an overall average of £1450 was achieved. No fresh milk, most being calved September/April. Buyers very keen for the younger  $2^{nd}-3^{rd}$  lactation cows and 4 times topped at £2000 with "Hazeldene Farm Joy" topping at £2205 closely followed by "Hazeldene Farm Grazie Poppy 2" at £2100, both due in September to Lakemead Jingle. Hereford heifers with growth and potential from Grist Estates to £1195 and a nice pen of 6 heifers from Merryfield Farmers to £1190 for 17mo. Younger steers and heifers in demand with 14mo from Grist Estates to £905 and 16mo to £820 from AE Flux. Younger farming steers £682 for 13mo from WS Stitch and £535 for 8mo from Pondhead Ltd.

Another good show of over 100 Angus met tremendous demand with several quality consignments setting the trade for the day. Yearling steers wanted and well-presented 14mo sold to £940 from CF & AM Martin of Sturminster Newton. Excellent younger steers from R Taylor & Sons sold from £875 - £900 (all only 10mo).

Heifers wanted and sold well to £1185 (21mo) from EG PJ & RJ Cary of Shepton Mallet. The good consignment of bulling heifers from FJ Lessey & Son met keen interest from £1060 to £1095 (all 22mo). Younger heifers wanted and sold from £920 - £930 (15mo) all from PW King of Ston Easton and yearlings from £750 - £815 from CF & AM Martin.

Good feeding steers wanted and sold to £1180 (23mo) from Tim Hiscock & family and double muscled yearling Limousin steers sold well to £1160 (13mo) from RE Dury & Son of Bristol. Best Continental heifers also in short supply but wanted with young quality Blue heifers selling to an amazing £1210 (17mo) from Merryfield Farmers. Yearling Blue heifers to £948 (14mo) from RE Dury & Son.


