

FEEDING BULLS

Frome has good buyers for young feeding bulls with demand outstripping supply. Young Limousin bulls wanted and sold to a massive £955 (only 9mo) from Tom & Charlotte Wheeler of Rode.

ORGANIC

Excellent consignments form regular vendors continue to meet a tremendous demand. CLIMATE

- More carbon is stored and/or sequestered

Applications for over £10,000 will be judged by a Local Assessment Panel. The Panel of 8 to 12 people includes representatives from Cranborne Chase AONB, Natural England and the farming and land management community as well as local specialists. The panel meets every 6 to 8 weeks. Applications for less than £10,000 are decided upon by a senior member of the AONB team (who has no prior knowledge of the project). **All projects are to be completed by 31st March 2025**.
