

A number of outstanding Limousin suckled types came forward this week. Brian Godwin & family brought their normal high-quality breeding to the sale which saw their 9-10mo Limousin steers always over £1000 and top at £1140. 9mo heifers from the same home at £788. 30 super Limousin suckled steers and heifers from regular supporter Nick Bond easily sold over £1000 for the steers and heifers from £750 - £850. Andrew Gale, Stourpain again showing his superb stock and his 13mo Limousin steers to £1232, £1195 and £1090, his heifers were in excellent demand to £1000, £995, £920.
