YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Trade continuing at the recent high levels and all buyers keen for the best conformation types. Neil & Sharon Glover again presenting super quality Charolais steers 6mo which peaked at an amazing £1015. Owen Nelmes produced some wonderful Limousin suckled steers 7-8mo which showed superb conformation at £1105, £1040 and £915. Heifers from the same home 8mo to £890. Another excellent annual consignment from young farmers Katie Ferrett & Josh Howden who saw their 50 (10-11mo) suckled steers and heifers produce tremendous bidding. Their Simmental steers easily to £970 while heifers at £840.

Phil Samways was well rewarded for making the trip from Swanage, as always presenting some of the top Simmentals as his homebred suckled steers 12mo peaked at £1278, £1100 and heifers to £1040. Very few younger Dairy bred Continental but all those with good conformation were wanted.

ANGUS

Quite amazing entries of Angus which today made up 50% of the total number on offer. RF Stratton again showing us wonderful support as they were forward with their annual run of 95 superb Angus steers and heifers (12mo). All were homebred and straight off the Deverill hills out of Friesian types. Buyers were very keen to purchase these grand cattle which saw pens of steers realise £998, £865 and £825 and heifers to £742, £710 and £660. Best quality single suckled steers 13mo from MA Wills commanded top bidding at £1030. Grand strong forward steers were in abundance with top spot to Tim & Paul Wilkinson to £1550, closely followed by J Trott & Sons at £1445. Smart suckled Angus steers (19mo) continuing to be forward from JH & JA Cool, IOW seeing excellent bidding at £1388, £1370 and £1305. Good deep bodied heifers at just 18mo from K & J Hames of Warminster were easily sold to £1125 while more nice sorts from A Doman & Co to £1035 and £1018. Super entries of good wintering/bulling heifers regularly £850 - £950 again this week. Smart good shaped suckled heifers 8mo often £800+. Overall, a fantastic day in this section.

FRIESIAN

Large entry of Friesians met a strong demand a fast trade for all ages. Some excellent consignments of large framed Friesians topped at £1330 for a cracking pen of 4 steers from Bill & Valerie Masters at 26mo. A super pen of 6 Friesian steers from PA & RJ Stranger & Sons sailed to £1250 for 27mo. Others from L Williams to £1065, younger sorts from M & T Gregory to £990 for 19mo and £980 from F Denning & Son for 18mo. Yearling Friesians from R & R Hole to £800 and the same price from G & R House. Younger steers again to £740 from AR Peters.

HEREFORD

What a show at Frome again with top honours of the day going to LP Shackell & Son of Bath with their tremendous steers selling to a massive £1670 (27mo). Best feeding steers sold to a strong demand at £1470 (25mo) from NR Hitchins of Paulton and £1400 (27mo) from PA & RJ Stranger & Sons. Younger well-presented steers also in demand selling to £1300 (18mo) from R Dix of Doulting, £1252 from B & P White of Castle Cary, £1185 (19mo) from Robin Pocock of Calne, £1095 from Nigel Doman and £1025 from M & T Gregory.

Heifers equally sought with fleshed heifers selling from £1200 to £1385 (26mo) all from B & P White and closely followed at £1335 (26mo) from Philip Stranger & family. Best bulling heifers sold from £1040 to £1095 (22mo) all from J Trott & Sons of Castle Cary and £1085 from A Doman & Co. Heifers with potential equally sold well to £950 from BG & TW Randall of Wareham, £945 from NR Hitchins and £840 from RD Brown of Frome.

FORWARD CONTINENTAL

Another tremendous day at Frome with an outstanding trade for best quality forward types. Exceptionally well reared Limousin and Blue steers from Philip Stranger & family of Shaftesbury topped at a massive £1665 (25mo) and £1570 (26mo) respectively and closely followed with Blue steers from Bill & Valerie Masters of Yeovil selling to £1600 (25mo). Younger Blue & Simmental steers also sold well to £1385 (17mo) and £1365 (19mo) respectively from JH & JA Cool of Isle of Wight. Similar Limousin steers also met a fast trade to £1355 (18mo) from BLK Farming of Fordingbridge. Younger suckler bred Simmental steers wanted and sold to £1278 (only 16mo) from Philip Samways of Swanage and similar Limousin steers also sold well to £1240 from FJ Burfitt of Zeals. Other good Blue steers sold from £1170 to £1198 all from B & P White of Castle Cary and £1160 from M & T Gregory of Sherborne. Heifers equally in demand with top honours going to Philip Stranger & family with his Blue heifers selling to a whopping £1450 (27mo). Other quality Blue heifers also sold well to £1285 (26mo) from B & P White. Younger Simmental heifers sold to £1240 (18mo) from PJ & PF Samways, £1230 (20mo) from David Gay Farming of Bath and £1130 (20mo) from Reg & Richard Hares of Alveston. Blue bulling heifers wanted and sold to £972 from GB & IMC Adams of Sturminster Newton and £960 (17mo) from F Denning & Sons of Yeovil, Limousin bulls also wanted and sold to £960 (17mo) from NB Parfitt of Bath and Simmental bulls to £950 from BG & TW Randall of Wareham.

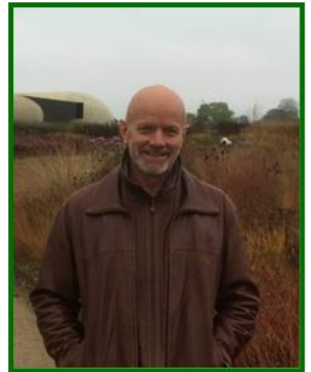
Applications for over £10,000 will be judged by a Local Assessment Panel. The Panel of 8 to 12 people includes representatives from Cranborne Chase AONB, Natural England and the farming and land management community as well as local specialists. The panel meets every 6 to 8 weeks. Applications for less than £10,000 are decided upon by a senior member of the AONB team (who has no prior knowledge of the project). **All projects are to be completed by 31st March 2025.**

Quotes must be received for each element of work in every application where Countryside Stewardship rates or rates from other agricultural support streams do not apply.
