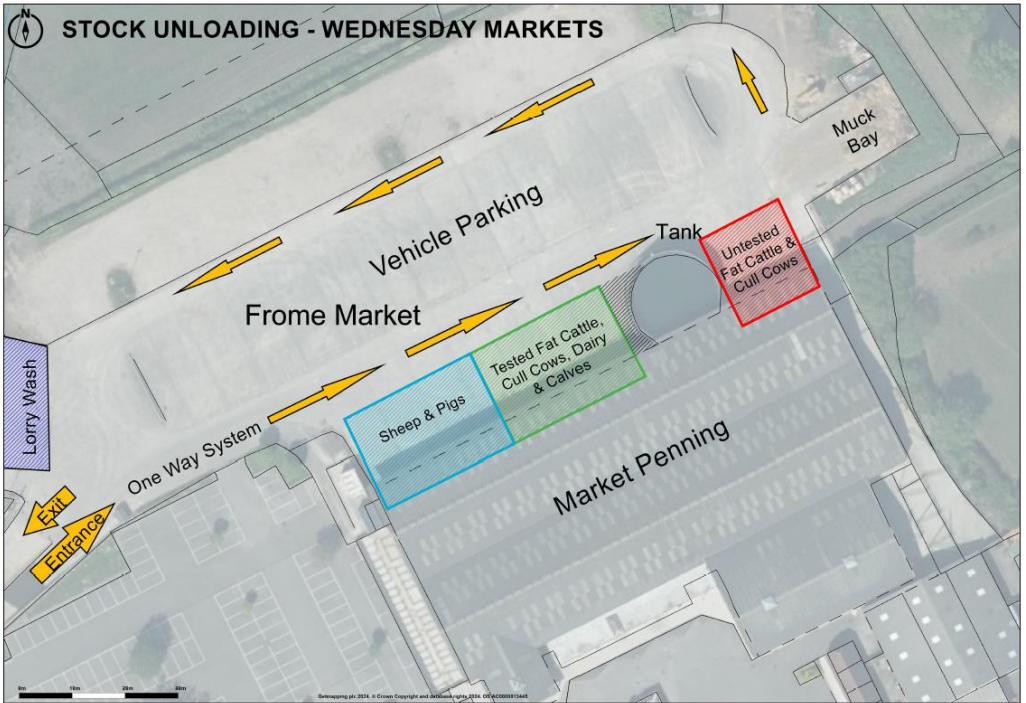

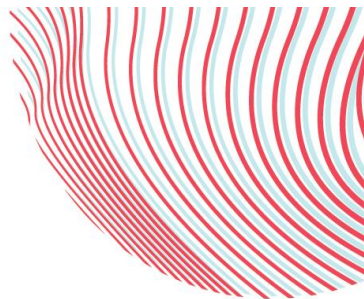

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

Although generally older types for this 1st Candlemas sale those younger cattle which were on offer had a wonderful trade. Plenty of men looking for those good suckler bred 10-14mo steers & heifers for early Spring grazing. Dairy bred leaner outwintered Continentals were also sold extremely well through the day.

ANGUS & HEREFORD

As expected, a grand show of Angus and Hereford today of both younger and more forward types. Quality varied considerably but every beast was wanted and a large complement of specific Angus finishers were present. Trade was at the highest of levels as the finished cattle prices continue to rise for the end product. Some bulling demand beginning to be evident.

FRIESIAN

The Candlemas sale continues to be synonymous with an excellent presentation of framed lean Friesian and fleshed types. All grades sold to advantage with several consignments well in excess of the recent national trade.

FORWARD CONTINENTAL

The traditional first Candlemas sale goes from strength to strength with an excellent show of cattle from regular and new vendors. Buyers came from all over the country wanting to fill artic loads of quality forward cattle that are proving to be a scarce national commodity. Good framed outwintered stock still hold a premium with a massive bidding frenzy forcing prices above expectations. Fleshed good condition cattle also met a tremendous trade with vendors benefiting from selling earlier than previous years.
