

When I was a lad there was a grant for ripping out hedges and orchards to create more land for food production!? Those dark days are so long gone..thank goodness! So we can expect new measures in the foreseeable future...the new measures would sit alongside existing restrictions that prevents removing hedgerows without planning consent. 9000 consultation responses had been received and highlighted Clear support from Farmers and Environmental groups for hedgerows to be protected by law!?
