

This week saw two super herd dispersals of suckler cows and calves comprising of 240 head. Although, they were both held under difficult circumstances being on behalf of the late Clive Groves and the late John Ponzo. Trade and support for these two regular vendors was wonderful from start to finish, first through the ring was 30 Galloway cows and their spring born calves for the Groves family of Sutton Mallet. These smaller hardy types which had been farmed on the Moorland and peat areas of the Sedge were keen sought and produced some very strong bidding. The ring was full, and buyers and bidders came from Lancashire in the North to Dartmoor in the South and most counties in between. Best sets were £1000 - £1400 with a top price of £1740 being achieved. Clive was a keen showman and cattle judge and had selected good stock sires for his herd, the youngest of which was "Dalesman of Kilnstown" a 3-year-old bull, he created great interest selling to a strong £2,400! and went to an established herd in Lancashire.

Following the Galloways came a large consignment from the late John Ponzo and was the last of a trilogy of sales on his behalf. The herd was of a mixed breed with Longhorns, Highlands, Hereford, Angus and pedigree Limousin dams being sold through the ring. The demand was excellent and with a breed to suit everyone the trade was set to fly! Longhorns with week old calves at foot were regularly £1200 - £1400, while Highlands ranged £600- £930 for both cows, calves and in calf cows. Angus x cows with Limousin x calves were all £1200 - £1400 too with many of the cows 10+ in age. Herefords were very much the same and peeked at £1600! British Blue x cows with Limousin x calves had a good day and always £1500 - £1600.

The icing on the cake was John's Pedigree Limousin cows and calves. Demand for these quality types was excellent, with sets at £3000, £2,800 £2,200 and £1,900. These were followed by the Limousin x cows and calves, plenty of sets £1700+ and with the best to £1,980. A sad day but also a great tribute to two wonderful friends of Frome Market. Thank you to all who supported us today.





Best steers always over £1100 and peaked at an excellent £1290, heifers from the same home were outstanding and 10mo "U" grade heifers were £1490, £1260, £1160 and £1155. 13mo Blue steers from new vendor Scott & Becky Kingston to £1085. Hard Limousin x 15mo steers off the plain from the late John Ponzo at £1240 16mo heifers from the same vendor at £1120. Another great day in this section.

ORGANIC

What a cracking run of organics here at Frome today where almost 150 were presented for sale. Demand was excellent throughout for all types. Stronger organics 18-22m on fire with grand Charolais steers topping at £1525-£1345. A strong entry from Neston Home Farm Ltd of Blue x Jersey steers and heifers saw competitive bidding, their older 26m+ steers peeked at £1480 and regularly £1100+.
