

BLUE TONGUE UPDATE WEDNESDAY 14th MAY

DEFRA have extended the temporary easing of pre-movement testing for Blue tongue for non-breeding livestock leaving the restricted zone. Specific licence EXD632 is still required but non-breeding cattle, goats and sheep over 60 days can now move without a BT pre-movement test. Only the following animals still require testing:

- Entire males intended for breeding
- Pregnant females (or pregnancy status unknown)
- Stock aged 60 days or younger (unless travelling at foot with the maternal dam where the maternal dam should be tested by PCR and ELISA)

This is a temporary change that will apply until 30th June 2025. DEFRA reserve the right to withdraw the extension at any time should new disease be confirmed.

Super Dairy Shorthorn steaking cows still over 280p/kg topping at 287p/kg from KJ Osborne & Partners. Thick young Irish Friesian cows up to 282p/kg. Plain Friesian Holstein black & whites a bit harder to place 160 – 200p/kg and eased on the week. Handy meat Friesian 240p/kg – 265p/kg generally. Herefords regularly 260 – 270p/kg and buyers were keen for these types particularly wanting heavier fleshed sorts. Although pence per head was back on last week, this was due predominantly to bigger numbers of plain cows forward for sale. Best meat cows £2000 or very close to this.

Calved Heifers £2550

What a wonderful day in the Dairy section. All sections were supported with real quality types throughout and all produced a superb trade with plenty of bidders and buyers around the ring. A number of excellent consignments were forward all from local vendors. First through the ring was home bred Holstein Friesian calved heifers from NR & D Norris. These quality heifers averaged over £2300 and peaked at £2580 for a 'Tulare' bred daughter. The 356th daughter from the 'Handson' blood line sold to £2400. We had two excellent consignments of in-calf heifers today. Firstly, we saw Tim Rawlings July - September calving Friesian Holstein heifers all were well grown calving at 2 and a half years to Angus. These were twice over £2200, topping at £2270 and averaged £2120. Next through the ring was another top consignment of 20 well-bred quality late June/July drawn calving heifers from Radstock Co-op Society due to sexed semen and Beef, these found tremendous interest. Plenty of these topped £2000 with the best £2300+ producing an average of £1983 . Following the in-calf heifers was a grand consignment of 35 Holstein Friesian bulling heifers again from Radstock Co-op Society. A pleasure to see such a nice entry and all created a lively trade topping at £1220 and averaged £1099.



HEREFORD & OTHER NATIVES

A wonderful trade for all Herefords this week. Demand for the little, younger cattle was excellent with 5mo steers and heifers from C G Capon selling to an amazing £840 and £800. 7mo heifers from the same farm also having a great day at £1230! Sweet smart summering heifers 10mo presented by the Gould family at £965. More forward Herefords had an outstanding trade and no sign of easing off the finished prices today! Phillip and Richard Stranger produced their normal quality animals with bunches of 23mo steers £1960 and £1695. Same age heifers £1695 and £1690! 30mo steers from the Thomas family Iron Acton peeked at an impressive £2260 with heifers at £1940. Prices generally on fire and more of the good types could have been sold this week.

ANGUS

Forward steers sailing to £2410 for well grown and fed steers from DH Masters & Son with others to £2230. A pen of 4 steers from GB Doel reached £2085 and RH Stevens' 18mo steers settled at £2045. Heifers from DH Masters & Son to £2065 for a pen of 6 and £1740 from RH Stevens. Younger well bred steers to £1890. Younger farming Angus wanted and a firm trade achieved.

FRIESIAN

Larger entry of over 50 forward this week met a fast trade with 25 well reared large framed turn out steers from Lower Bagber Farms Ltd of Sturminster Newton setting the trade and selling from £1540 (16mo) to £1735 (19mo). Other large framed steers selling equally well to £1525 from Philip Stranger & Family of Shaftesbury and £1425 from AJ & GG Thomas of Iron Acton. FORWARD CONTINENTAL

Best Continentals are still bucking the trend of reducing finished trade with strong bidding holding prices above expectations.
