211 STORES 26 FAT 4 CULL 313 CALVES & REARED CALVES STEERS TO £1960 HEIFERS TO £1885

Good entry of stores for our July TB sale. Well presented and fed cattle continuing to sell well however, a number of stock showing signs of the lack of grass, these being generally harder work.

### PRIME CATTLE (26) Max.351.5p/kg £2633

A good entry of finished cattle forward this month with a nice consignment of mainly Hereford x steers and heifers from Pipplepen Farm. Although Non-Assured, trade was lively for these butchers types. Plenty of handy weight steers (500-600kg) 330-340pkg with lighter weights under 500kg 340-343pkg and steers £1700-£1900. Heifers were very well covered and slightly fat in some instances but never the less all sold well. Thick over 30mo heifers full of meat topped at over £2200 and often 300-340pkg. 500kg+ underage Hereford heifers grossing £1750-£1920 330-351pkg. "R" 4L grade quality Angus from Lockerly Hall Farm to 337.5pkg grossing £1950! Gloucester x rigs to £2241 with smart under 30mo Angus £2400 - £2633. Overall, a very satisfactory trade in this section.

## CULL COWS Max 300p/kg £2449

Only a small entry but plenty of trade. More could have been sold well today. Thicker Hereford x cows from Pipplepen to 287.5pkg. Angus x steaking cows from W Stitch to 264.5pkg. Very smart "u" grade Blue cows from Andy Gale saw wonderful competitive bidding to 300pkg.

### **STORE CATTLE (211)**

Another well supported store cattle section for our July sale. As the very dry spell continues to bite harder by the day it was however a surprisingly lively trade throughout. A very good compliment of buyers were in attendance with new purchasers forward for this sale.

#### **HEREFORD AND ANGUS**

Not the numbers of stronger cattle present this time but those that were sold to an advantage. Deep bodied well grown Angus steers 16mo from M Sawyer were keenly sought to £1960, while more dairy types from regular vendor PJ JM & A Eavis £1760 and JC & MJ Mayo at £1500. Smaller longer term Angus steers £800-£1180. Short term Angus heifers with good coverage were wanted and nice sorts from Mayo & Son to £1885 closely followed by M Sawyer £1730. Lockerly Hall Farm saw their sweet well-shaped Angus heifers 14-15mo to a strong £1585. Fed 10-12mo heifers from Vince and Langdon Turner to £860. Herefords varied in quality but all sold well. Good strong steers from JR Griffin Devizes topped out at £1880 and £1500. Very few Hereford heifers today and those forward lacking in confirmation generally £1200-£1400.

#### CONTINENTAL

Mainly Blues in this section and to be honest a number of well-shaped cattle were forward. As with the rest not too many older types but trade very firm. Quality "R" grade steers 16mo again from M Sawyer to £1900!! Younger types £1585 with most £1300-£1500. Same vendor smart heifers £1800-£1700. Pete Evans Blue heifers £1635 and Mayo & Son £1205. Overall, a better than anticipated trade throughout. Thank you to all who supported today.

#### CALVES & REARED CALVES (313) Max

A large entry continue to sell with new buyers here for TB stock. Leaner older reared calves 8-10mo would be a more selective trade.

#### **REARED CALVES**

Blue bulls 7mo to £740 and heifers to £700 and £550. Younger freshly weaned Blue bulls (2-3mo) to £545 and £532. A tidy run of Angus 4-5mo saw steers to £570 and heifers to £405 all looking well sold for TB restricted. Charolais steers to £590(6mo) and £562.

#### CALVES

Best Blue bulls to £688, £565, £550 and heifers to £405. Medium Blue bulls to £350 and heifers to £300. Smaller Blue bulls to £250 and heifers to £175. Better end Angus bulls (4-6wo) to £385, £380 and £340 and heifers to £250-£280. Medium Angus bulls to £280 and heifers £200-£220. Smaller bulls up to £200 and heifers £130-£140. A number of Arla and calves under withdrawal periods generally harder work and several of these sorts below £20. Please endeavour to present calves over 56 days if possible and not under any withdrawals. Medium Hereford bulls to £275 and heifers to £265. Stabiliser bulls proving popular to £465 and £415 with medium bulls to £270 and medium heifers to £190.

#### **DAIRY BRED**

Holstein Friesian bulls to £450 and Fleckvieh steers to £400. Hard Dairy steers showing the 'weather' a very hard sell to £188. Medium Holstein Friesian Calves from £120-£145.
