What another very strong day in the Dairy section. A number of super consignments coming forward including a small dispersal for DA James & Son of Tangiers Farm, Frome having decided to cease milk production. Trade was excellent for these super genuine Friesian Holstein and Fleckvieh heifers and cows seeing an average of £2013 ranging from 1st to 5th calvers. 'Larcrest' sires Friesian Holstein heifers, later lactation, topped the sale at £23890 with 2nd lactation 'Spruce-Haven' daughter to £2380. 4th lactation Montbeliarde November calving cow easily to £2300. Several Fleckvieh cows were included in the herd

which saw very keen competition for November heifers due with their 2nd £2220 and £2160 and many 4th-5th lactation over £2000. Older cows saw good interest all day regularly £1400 - £1600. Following these were two super consignments of August/September due Holstein Friesian heifers. Despite the lack of grazing and the fierce temperatures, a better than expected trade was had, particularly for the medium and shorter term cattle. Slight resistance in trade on the younger end stores was seen but certainly not disastrous.

### **BULLS, COWS & CALVES**

Only one set forward and although a younger leaner cow demand was strong topping at £1710 for an Angus with Angus steer calf at foot. Senior 4yo Devon bulls to £1605.

### YOUNG CONTINENTAL

A much brighter than expected trade as the hot weather continues and harvest well under way. Good single suckler bred Limousin from Philliols Farm 8-10mo saw steers at £1295 and heifers at £1100. More top-grade Limousin from Local vendor GJ & SE Welch & Sons 13-14mo saw best pen of heifers to an excellent £1870, £1740, £1640 with more £1350-£1500. 
