A very busy cull section this week and gradually gaining momentum with 72 head on offer. A much better selection of cows present and everyone around the ring keen to buy. Many more well fleshed cows on offer both beef bred and black & whites which saw strong prices. A super consignment of steaking and export Angus cows from Masters & Partners regularly over 260p/kg with their best to 280p/kg topping at 300p/kg (£2015). More good, thick Angus cows from JB Groves 297.5p/kg (£2326), fleshed Devon x export types from the Wrixon family 285-293.5p/kg and were well sold. Most of the fleshed beef cows in excess of £1800 today. Black & whites saw keen competition with fleshed types from R J Phillips regularly £1700-£2000 topping at £2002. RDP Stevens produced some well fleshed steaking cows 250-270p/kg £1600-£1800. Feeding cows often 240-280p/kg with Charolais from the Goodall family to 281.5p/kg. Single suckled quality younger steers all selling to an advantage. Well covered forward stores saw plenty of interest throughout.

Suckler cows with quality young calves still seeing a firm trade. Nice Fleckvieh cows with 22day Blue heifer calf from DA James & Son topped at £1900. Plainer lean cows with 2-3mo Beef Shorthorn calves continuing to be wanted ranging from £1410-£1750.

BULLS


