A few more numbers forward this week, generally cattle entered carrying much better cover than on previous occasions. A good consignment of continental heifers from Malcolm and Abbey Robinson created strong interest which saw handy weights (under 600kg) 350 - 355pkg on a regular basis. Heavier weights over 600kg found the best demand and with plenty of flesh sold 360pkg to top at 370pkg and consistently grossing £2200 - £2500, well done to Malc and Abbey!! These were closely followed by a super "R" grade Blue heifer from R Adams £2264. Sweet, young, continental lightweight butchers' heifers (16mo) from Potticks Pigs sold well at 339.5pkg and just short of £1800! Traditional Hereford and Angus O+ heifers under 600kg from Nigel Doman and family at 349.5pkg grossing £2000 and showing healthy returns. 
