A few less cows than anticipated but nevertheless close to 40 penned for sale. There were a good sample of fleshed cows forward which produced strong competition throughout the sale. A wonderful consignment of deep bodied export and steaking black and white cows from RL Clapp & Sons sold in excess of £2100 on no less than 11 occasions peaking at an excellent £2600! Most well fleshed heavy export cows 270-280p/pk topping at 291.5p/kg for a super Beef Shorthorn from Alistair Hammond. Other beef breeds selling well with thick Hereford x from the Woodward family at 279.5p/kg. Young feeding cows generally 200-220p/kg with a few older feeding sorts 180-200p/kg. Plainer older cows mainly black and white 150-170p/kg. Not too many boners this week but a firm trade 125-150p/kg for those on offer. Overall, I felt trade a little firmer on the week with definitely demand for the dried-up meat types.




