



**An outstanding September market with a tremendous entry of very well presented smart store cattle. A packed ringside encouraged by the recent 'growing' weather.**

### ORGANIC

Close to 100 organics forwards for our September sale. Trade was excellent throughout and the recent rain has certainly had a good effect on confidence around the ring! Regular supporters J & M King Brain produced another quality entry of suckler bred cattle and trade matched the cattle. Their Beef Shorthorn 23mo steers topped at £2270 and Simmental steers from the same home to £2000. Younger 15/16mo Hereford and Angus steers £1520 and £1660 respectively. Super South Devon heifers 23mo again from J & M King Brain topped at £1800! 
