Overall a much better entry of fleshed cattle were available to the buyers and this was reflected in the trade that followed. Plenty of steers over 350p/kg and some super Simmental, Limousin and Blues from Edward and Lucy Hicks & family 365 -371.5p/kg and all being R+ grades. A number of thick fleshed Angus steers were presented and good types from A Doman & Co, Will Weaver and Waddon Farm Ltd 340-360p/kg regularly over £2300 topping at £2692!! Heavy weight steers wanted and good Limousin fleshed steers from Will Weaver & family topped at £2500 (359.5p/kg). 
