news! Countryside Stewardship **Mid Tier Agreements** have been extended for a further year for approx 5000 farmers whose current agreement would end on 31 Dec. This is while Government reforms SFI, EIP and rolls out the High tier Countryside Stewardship scheme. The **RPA** are writing to eligible farmers about their extended offer.

There are apples everywhere this year..here in the countryside it's a job to even give them away!!? Thatchers started harvesting just before the August bank holiday...first time in 120 years. 
