A fantastic Annual Christmas Fatstock Show produced excellent attendance and a record price for the Supreme Champion at 760p/kg. A big thank you to everyone who supported this hugely successful day.

This week saw our annual Christmas fatstock show and sale at Frome market. The show and sale was extremely well supported and, while a full sale report and results are available separately, I can confirm it was an outstanding day and trade for the high-quality show cattle on offer was excellent. The supreme champion beast of the show was an outstanding Aberdeen Angus heifer from local vendor Stuart Perkins of H G Perkins and Son which sold for a record price of 760p/kg, grossing almost £5000 and purchased by Mr Steve Tucker on behalf of the White Row Farm Shop. Reserve champion was a lovely Charolais heifer from regular show supporter Laura Bodman and her family; this sweet butcher's heifer topped at an excellent 570p/kg being purchased by the judge Mr Ed Davis. A good total entry of over 75 head came through the ring seeing 50 show cattle and 25 commercials. Commercial trade varied according to quality but some strong prices maintained for the Christmas trade. Plenty of good unhandled continental steers 400 – 440p/kg which saw Laura Bodman, Steve & Rachel Stamp and Mark & Kate Lanfear all at 439.5p/kg. Deep bodied Limousin steers from Richard & Londene Garraway and Malcolm & Abbey Robinson both at 369.5p/kg, with good Angus steers from H G Perkins & Son also at 369.5p/kg (£3000). Leaner 20mo Hereford steers coming from Austin Smith were at 361.5p/kg. Suckler bred 'R' grade heavy steers from CR Hartley settled at 354.5p/kg while young Angus steers at just 18mo from A E Weaver & Son achieved 354.5p/kg. Certainly a good day for heifers with some great animals forward, smart Limousin again from the Robinson family topping at 364.5p/kg grossing £2600. Nice handy weight heifers from Rob Singleton and family always wanted at 357.5p/kg. Overall, a tremendous day and a big thank you to all who supported the sale.


