

Another strong demand this week for all cattle grades and ages which bodes well for our first Candlemas sale next week.

COWS & CALVES

This week saw an increased number of cows and calves with the reduction sale from WJ Doggrell & Son of Templecombe setting the trade well with their Charolais cows with heifer calves at foot setting from £1660 to £1880. Their in calf 9-10yo Charolais cows equally well bid from £1690 to £1700.

GRAZING COWS
