## **FORWARD CONTINENTALS**

Trade continues to go from strength to strength with demand continuing to outstrip supply. The amazingly well reared Limousin steers from MD & DR James of Chippenham took top honours of the day with their best pen of steers selling to a tremendous £2560 (only 21mo), £2470 and £2360 (22mo). Similar well presented Simmental steers from Mark Ford of Buckland Newton equally selling well to £2530 (only 24mo), £2390 (22mo), £2280, £2240, £2085 and £2065 (19mo). Forward Blue steers also well bid, selling to £2410 (30mo) from Nigel & David Masters of Maperton and other fleshed steers selling from £2025 (19mo) to £2060 (26mo) from Mark Ford and other good conformation Blue steers to £2030 (only 18mo) from Scott Kingston of Tresham. Longer term Simmental steers from Mrs Marklove of Swindon met the usual tremendous trade selling to £1925 (18mo) and their yearlings to £1870 (11mo). Quality forward Limousin steers wanted and selling to £1870 (only 16mo) from Robert & Jayne Mayo of Weymouth. Longer term Blues also keenly bid to £1850 from both W Green & Sons of Horningsham and Keevil Farm Partnership. Heifers continue to amaze with fleshed Limousin heifers selling to £2305 (only 20mo) from MD & DR James, and similar Simmental heifers selling to £2290 and £2090 (only 23mo) from Mark Ford, his Blue heifers equally sought after selling to £2140 (26mo) and younger heifers to £1895 (20mo). Other younger Blue heifers also selling well to £1795 (17mo) and £1640 (15mo) from Keevil Farm Partnership, £1760 from Andy & Vicky Booth T/A PK Frampton of Dewlish and £1620 (16mo) from BA & CM Godwin & Sons of Bath.

## **DAIRY BRED**

Like all other breeds Friesian seeing good demand. Holstein Friesians generally £1400-£1600 topping at £1620 (18mo) from Robert & Jayne Mayo, £1460 from Will Stitch and £1400 from PK Frampton. British Friesian types to £1695 from DS Currell of East Harptree. Heifers continue selling well with freemartins to £1930 from Jayne Mayo and £1680 for PK Frampton. Very hard young heifers met tremendous bidding to £1055 from Yeatman Partners of Belchalwell.




