

## **FORWARD CONTINENTALS**

Trade continues to go from strength to strength with demand continuing to outstrip supply. Longer term Simmental steers from Mrs Marklove of Swindon met the usual tremendous trade selling to £1925 (18mo) and their yearlings to £1870 (11mo). Quality forward Limousin steers wanted and selling to £1870 (only 16mo) from Robert & Jayne Mayo of Weymouth. Longer term Blues also keenly bid to £1850 from both W Green & Sons of Horningsham and Keevil Farm Partnership. 


