CULL COWS Max 277.5p/kg £2236.65

PRIME CATTLE Max 371.5p/kg £2502.42

As with the store cattle trade it was equal to a Wednesday clean market. Strong deep bodied export cows peaked at 277.5p/kg (grossing over £2200). Grazing plainer feeding cows regularly 220-250p/kg. Non-assured & no VAN steers & heifers sold well with best steers at 371.5p/kg and heifers to 349.5p/kg. More of these could have been well sold.

STORE CATTLE (111)

No let up in the trade for today's Monday TB Auction. Demand for the 120 stores was exceptional from start to finish. Prices were certainly no different to our normal Friday market and more could have been well sold today.

Forward cattle all seeing super prices and quality types regularly over £2000 this month. Mark Sawyer saw his 16-17month British blue steers top at £2200! A wonderful consignment of South Devon x Stabiliser suckled beef steers 22-24 months, created furious bidding with bunches at £2400, £2390, £2370 and £2350 all from regular supporters James & Peter Corp. 16 Month Blue x steers from George & Peter James, Frome produced excellent prices at £1990 & heifers 16 months at £1770.

Forward traditional Angus & Hereford all extremely well sold with Dairy 0+ conformation steers from Pete Gould & family to £2270 with his heifers £2060 and £1960; Angus from The Davey family also £2060 and £2000! Younger cattle very dear with a good run from C & R Padfield (11-14 months) selling at top levels with 11 month Blue x steers £1500 & heifers at £1410. Young Angus £1400-£1500 all day long. A strong entry from Houghton Farming 6-8 months had a storming trade with everyone keen for these hard types; most ranged £700-£900 and equal to the commercial normal market overall an excellent day in the store ring at Frome Market.

Not quite as many forward as we had booked due to license failure's etc. however a very firm trade for all grades.

REARED BULLS / STEERS TO £745 & HEIFERS TO £650

Just a few of these this month with Blue bulls 3 months from Wyke Farms to £745 & heifers to £650. Blue Bulls from RH & MJ Hurford to £665 & Blue Heifers from BA Marsh to £598 who also had Ayrshire bulls to £450. Angus bulls from RP & VRM Reakes to £460 & £402 again from RH & MJ Hurford. Tidy Hereford x bulls 8-10 weeks from RP Sainsbury to £450.

CONTINENTAL BULLS TO £640 & HEIFERS TO £430

Best Blue bulls to £640 from regular supporters J Sprake & Partners, others to £545 from University of Bristol, £490 from Wyke Farms. Younger fresher bulls to £390 from The Helliar Partnership, £340 RH & MJ Hurford, £338 from University of Bristol and £310 Wyke Farms. Medium Blue heifers wanted to £430 from RH & MJ Hurford, £390 from RP & VRM Reakes & Sons, £352 from J.Sprake & Partners, £350 BA Marsh Farming, £310 from Wyke Farms. Smaller heifers looking very well sold to £265 from BA Marsh, £260 University Of Bristol, £260 J Sprake, £260 Alvis Bros. Simmental bulls from J.Sprake & Partners to £590 & heifers to £300.

NATIVE BULLS TO £390 & HEIFERS TO £270

A big entry of Hereford x from Guy Chandler & family saw well-presented Hereford x bulls to £390, & £300, the smaller younger sorts from £140-£215. Their younger heifers saw the very smallest from £75 up to £178. All of these would be out of a cross bred type cow! Other Herefords from Wyke Farms saw heifers to £270 & bulls to £255. Tidy Angus x bulls from RP Sainsbury to £375, £370 from RH & MJ Hurford, £340 RP & RM Reakes & Sons, £300 Radstock Co-Op. Younger bulls to £252 from The Helliar Partnership & £190 Alvis Bros Ltd. Lighter weight bulls £110-£150. Medium Angus x heifers to £258 from Wyke Farms, £258 Helliar Partnership, £215 BA Marsh. Younger Angus heifers to £195 from Radstock Co-op, £185 from RH & MJ Hurford, £156 from RP Sainsbury and £150 from Alvis Bros. Angus steers from Fern Meadow to £280. Longhorn heifers to £152 from University of Bristol.

DAIRY BRED

A firm trade for fed calves with best Holstein Friesian bulls to £248 from The Helliar Partnership & £240 from Wyke Farms. Mediums to £165 again from the Helliar Partnership & £150 from Guy Chandler. Lighter weight types from £40-£80 along with Jersey bulls also £40-£80, the best end of these saw £147 & £150 again from The Chandlers. Light weight Jersey heifers to £78. Tidy Ayrshire bulls from Ben Marsh flying to £280 & £240. More wanted for our next TB Sale 20.04.26.
