Good numbers here today with many more required to satisfy demand. A blistering trade for all types and grades. Cow and calf outfits keenly contested and hard feeding bulls looking well sold.

COWS & CALVES

This week saw a wonderful entry of beef suckler cows, calves and in calf heifers through our ring at Frome. The majority entered were a dispersal for Crocus Farming Ltd of their Luining and Longhorn suckler herd. Younger Luining cows with 9mo steers and heifer calves at foot saw huge interest with sets well over £3000 and topping at £3350. Next were the Longhorn cows and calves often over £2000 and peaked at £2700. Their in-calf Longhorn heifers saw strong bidding ranging £1700-£2000 all through the sale. Overall demand for these good hard outwintered cattle was superb from start to finish!

BULLS

Well presented yearling bulls met a keen trade with Limousins to £2090 (12mo) and Angus to £2000 (11mo) from Tom & Martin Bartlett of Weymouth. This week saw a tremendous consignment of 36 single suckled Limousin steers and heifers 10-12mo from PB Farm Enterprises, IOW. The full complement of buyers were very keen to acquire these quality types with pens of steers £1790, £1740 and £1690; heifers from the same home were equally sought and these good confirmation sorts regularly £1715-£1600! 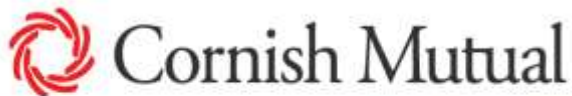
