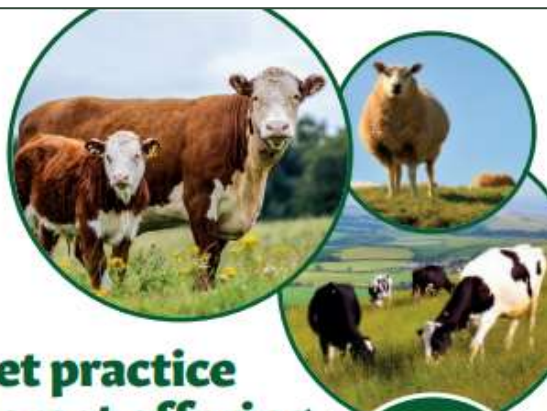

Trade improves in line with the increased demand for finished cattle with steers to £2180 and heifers to £2150.

SUCKLER COWS & CALVES

Only a handful of suckler cows and calves in this week, but what a trade. A lovely consignment from Pete Cooke & family created strong bidding, seeing Hereford x cows with Angus heifers to £2390, while Angus cows with Angus heifers topped at £2520.

ORGANIC

Organic numbers a bit scarce for our June sale but good demand and bidding very brisk. Good shaped Blue x dairy heifers 18mo from vendors Daniell & Hole sold easily to £1985 and £1840. Well presented black and white Hereford x Friesian heifers forward from the Durston family were wanted to £1850. More could have been sold on this improving trade.

ANGUS

Quality cattle forward met an improved trade as demand increases following the increasing finished trade. Fleshed steers from VW Harvey Partnership of Yeovil set the trend at an outstanding £2180 (27mo) and closely followed at £2120 (28mo) from Nigel Masters and family of Maperton. Forward heifers equally sought after selling to £2065 (only 19mo) for JJ Taylor & Son of Bristol, and their younger heifers to £1780 (17mo). Other heifers also well bid to £1870 (29mo) and older heifers well sold from £1700-£1760 (30-31mo) from Clifford Alvis & family of Radstock. Bulling heifers also wanted to £1640 (22mo) from Roger Phillips & family, £1630 from Sam & Guy Jenkins, £1550 Nigel Masters, £1540 Derek & Bridget Gorge and £1505 from Daniel Bessant of Lyndhurst. Yearling steers continue to excel with best 15mo steers selling from £1915 to £1965 from Sam & Guy Jenkins, £1890 (15mo) from JJ Taylor & Son and £1875 (13mo) from David Hill & family of Doultling. Younger 12mo steers also keenly bid to £1550 from JR & JB Marshall. Younger heifers also wanted selling to £1380 for Tynning Farms of Kilmersdon.

HEREFORD

Trade for the native and Hereford breeds excellent today. S & G Gould presented a super run of young Hereford x Friesain with 7-8mo steers at £1090 and heifers at £995! Very few forward Herefords on offer, which were mainly in the organic section with strong heifers at £1850.

FORWARD CONTINENTAL

The stronger finished trade bought more quality forward cattle for sale today which sold above expectations. The quality reared younger types met the fastest trade with the exceptional entry of Limousin steers from JJ Taylor & Son of Bristol selling to a massive £2070 (only 14mo) closely followed with Charolais steers from VW Harvey Partnership of Yeovil selling at £2050 (26mo).
