

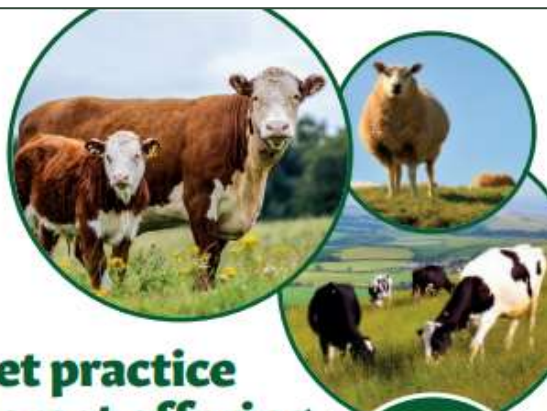

The pathway is closed now for Cattle, Sheep and Pigs.. find more information on the gov.uk site.

Property Protection Trusts are available with most Wills.. to make sure, in the event of your death, that your property is passed on to those to whom you intend it to go(ie children, maybe from a previous marriage) Just another matter to think about I know, but, I believe for a farming family it's vital!?

With many farmers now looking at other important inheritance matters **First Registration** of the land they own is also important!? A **Compliant Land Registry Plan** can provide a much greater degree of certainty regarding **Legal Title**, alongside other **Recognised Boundary Indicators**.
