The heavier cattle looked a little less on the week per kilo, however, 'weight in money' and plenty of quality 'R & U' grade Limousin steers and heifers from RW & MA Loxton over £2300 and topped at £2507!! A nice consignment from Edward and Lucy Hicks saw their Simmental steers 334.5p/kg and over £2300. Charolais from the same home 341.5p/kg. Native thick butchers steers produced firm demand with O+ tidy Angus steers from Roger Coombes and family at 334.5p/kg. Grand South Devon steers from James Burrough sold well 341.5p/kg (£2300). Dairy (non breeder) black and white heifer to 317p/kg. Non assured cattle a little hard to place generally 290-310p/kg. Well fleshed continental heifers produced the highest prices per kilo this week with smart Limousin from Edward and Lucy Hicks 357.5p/kg closely followed by Andrew Loxtons Limousin at 354.5p/kg. Light weight Angus heifers generally 310-330p/kg but most O+ and O- grades this week.

A superb entry of lambs in terms of numbers, however a lot of lambs were very lean and some would have been better sold in the stores. Just because lambs are weighing 40kg it does not mean that they are fit; plenty of very lean forward which are not killing at a very high percentage. Keep feeding the lambs as there is no goodness in the grass. Handy weights to 364p/kg from Isla Watts and £162 from Gerald Williams. Heavies to 402p/kg from Stuart Coombes of Bridgwater and £202 from the same good home. Over 52kg to 387p/kg from Jonathan Sprake & Partners and £220 from the Lyons family. Fed lambs are paying dividends at the moment.

A friend was telling me yesterday how he makes sure all his vehicles have a suitably sized **Fire extinguisher on all farm Machinery** (Having had his combined ignite and cause the field to catch fire!))Also, for those with farm bowsers and water storage..to make sure that the local **fire brigade have the correct adaptor** for the store hoses/fittings! Here are numbers you can contact for help if you feel you or anyone you know needs it? If so, don't ignore the signs. **ASK THEM HOW THEY ARE!** Farmers take great pride in being fiercely **independent and resilient**. They can find it hard to admit that things are getting too much!
