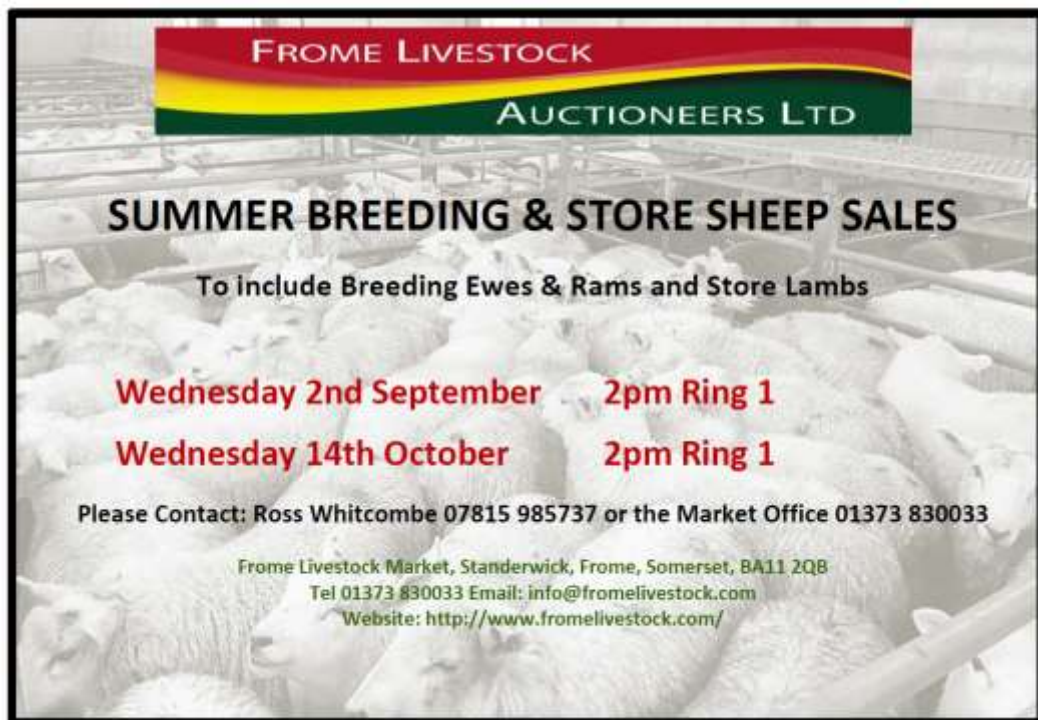
CULL EWES & RAMS (211) Max £191

A lot of longer term grazing ewes forward today with the best of them to £151 from PJ Pobjoy & Son, £144 DJ & EJ Mitchell and £140 P Hulbert. Most ewes £100 to £120 today. Still plenty of buyers around looking for grazers but best meat ewes still look strong enough.

A tidy entry of all medium-term Angus saw best steers from the Gould Family to £1910. Others from FJ Lessey & Son saw £1800 and a grand run from Dennis & Jason Crofts to £1720, £1700 and £1695. Younger sorts from PR & AT Hill to £1720, £1700 from D & GJ Stevens and £1580 from Messrs Doar. Young dairy bred Angus steers from HJ Master & Son to £1055 and £1090 from TJ Harris. Angus heifers again from Dennis & Jason Crofts to £1665. Others to £1495 from Richard Pearce, £1470 from D & GJ Stevens and £1460 from the Gould family.

HEREFORD & BEEF SHORTHORN

Another tremendous day at Frome with bidding outstripping supply. The highlight of the day was Mrs Sarah Lloyd-Harris of Powerstock selling 63 cattle. Her Beef Shorthorn steers topped at £1880 (16mo) and Hereford heifers to £1810 (27mo). Her younger 16mo Hereford steers also well bid to £1760 and her young Beef Shorthorn steers met a sensational demand selling for £1700 to £1710 (only 16-17mo). Their heifers also sold to a premium with Beef Shorthorn heifers to £1510 (17mo) and Hereford heifers to £1410 (16mo). Other well-presented Herefords steers also benefited from the trade selling to £1800 (22mo) from Rupert & Vernon Loder of Yeovil and younger steers to £1530 from Derek & Graham Stevens of Maiden Bradley. Yearling steers wanted and topped at £1300 from T J Harris from Glastonbury. Other heifers keenly bid to £1490 (22mo) from FJ Lessey & Son of Wincanton and 16mo heifers to £1350 from ML & RI Loder.

Young Red Ruby Devon's from Fred Ford of South Cheriton also showed well selling to £1090 (only 8mo).
