Farmers in the agreement will be able to create **Firebreaks** and permit to **cut and graze** land in the agreement.2. extra 50m for sustainable farming, total budget now 290m. 3. Taking action to make it easier to create reservoirs & a further 15m for this purpose.4. The EA will prioritise requests for short term variations to **Abstraction licence conditions....**
