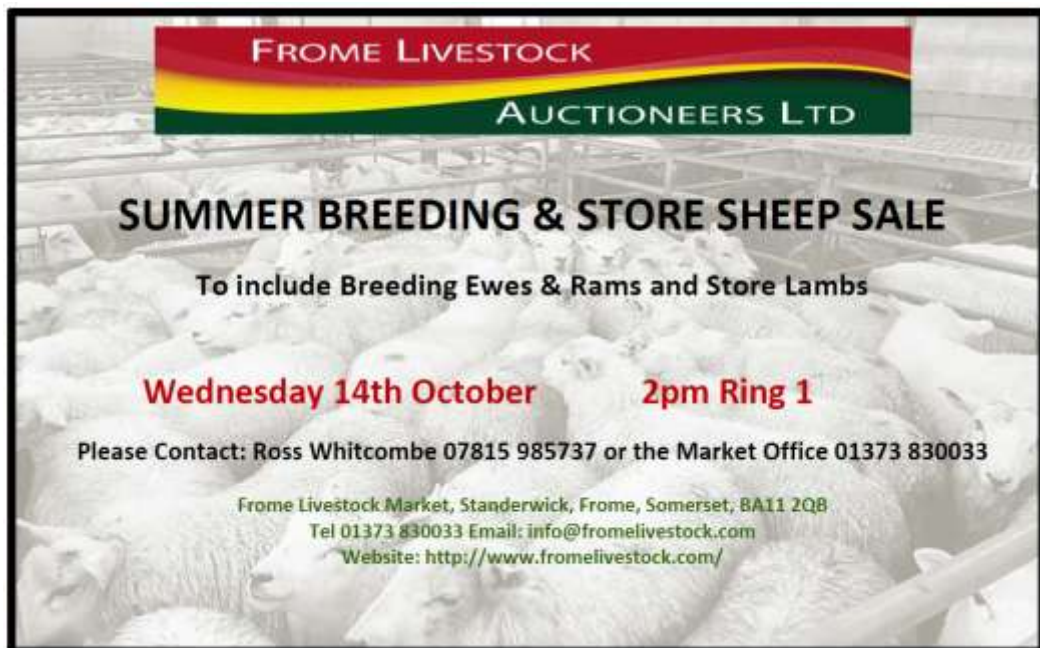

A strong trade in this section with some quality forward types from Arminca Ltd, Blandford. Their well grown deep bodied 16mo Angus steers commanded premium prices to £2305! And £2200 respectively. More good sorts from the Tayler family saw 10mo steers at £1600 and 20mo heifers at £1880. More organics could have been well sold today.
